TERMS OF REFERENCE & REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS FROM SERVICE PROVIDERS

TO REPAIR TEST AND COMMISSION 1250A, 17.5KV CIRCUIT BREAKER AT THE NGAGANE WATER PURIFICATION PLANT

1. Introduction:

As a bulk water supplier, it is the intention of uThukela Water to request quotations from suitable services providers to repair, test and commission a Circuit Breaker at the Ngagane Water Purification Plant.

2. Background:

uThukela Water assets and infrastructure include the Ngagane Water Purification Plant, and pump stations. As a Water Service Provider uThukela Water is responsible for the maintaining of the Water Purification Plants, pump stations and pipelines within its areas of responsibility.

3. Requirements:

The scope of work includes the repairing, testing and commissioning of a 1250A Circuit Breaker at the Ngagane Water Purification Plant Sub-station. All materials, spares, labour and transportation are to be included in the quotation. Below is a table containing the scope of work.

<u>TABLE:</u>
1. Strip existing breaker. 1250A, 17.5KV
2. Repair/refurbish trolley and insulated stems.
3. Repair/replace breaker.
4. Assemble, test and commission breaker.
<u>Notes:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Quotations are to include: Supply, delivery and the installation of all materials, spares, labour and transportation.

4. Quotations must be submitted in one of the following ways:

- Bids will be adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2017 pertaining to Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 5/2000 and other applicable legislations, and will be based on 80/20 points system. Preference points will be awarded to service providers using their B-BBEE status level of contribution.

- Quotations in a sealed envelope marked with the relevant reference number for the attention of the Procurement Officer" may be placed in the tender box in the reception of uThukela Water **OR**

- The supplier of a successful quotation must be on the UTW financial system before an order will be issued. Please contact the Procurement Officer for details of the procedure to be included on the vendor's list.
- Bids will be adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2017 pertaining to Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 5/2000 and other applicable legislations, and will be based on 80/20 points system. Preference points will be awarded to service providers using their B-BBEE status level of contribution.
- **A compulsory site meeting will be held, all service providers will meet at the Ngagane Water Purification Plant. The site meeting will be held on Thursday 12th September 2023 at 10h00. Failing to attend the site meeting will disqualify the service provider.**
