1	The RFP document under section 3.5 (PAGE 13 OF 88) calls for company and professionals experience on "similar projects". Similar projects are defined as:	Yes, the Hotels & Leisure projects are included BUT implemented in live and operational environments.
	"Similar projects are those that were implemented in live and operational environments relating to Airport terminals, shopping malls, Office parks, Hospitals, Major transport hubs."	
	CLARIFICATION REQUESTED: Is the list definitive (ie, limited to the specific list of Airport terminals, shopping malls, Office parks, Hospitals, Major transport hubs) or would hotel & leisure projects also qualify?	
2	Just want to know if we can put schools and police stations in as references.	Schools and Police stations are not considered as similar projects and therefore should not be included as reference projects. They do not have the same level of complexity.
3	Would you be so kind and please confirm whether pages 81 – 86 (Form 4.5.26 Occupational Health and Safety Questionnaire) should also be completed by Architects?  We are submitting a bid for Architect Services only and therefore want to know if it is still a requirement for Architects to complete these specific pages as well.	Form 4.5.26 is a standard Questionnaire where ACSA requires the Bidder to declare whether within its Organisation / Company, they observe and comply with requirements of the Occupation Health & Safety Act through availability of a SHE Policy (Compliance and undertaking of SHE Training, SHE inspections, etc). This is in line with the requirement of The Occupational Health and Safety Act, Act 85 of 1993, which requires the Employer to provide and maintain as far as reasonable a work environment that is safe and without risk to the health of its employees. It is also an important declaration for ACSA to note whether organisations / companies it contracts with comply with the requirements of the OHS Act as they undertake the work that they will be contracted for under the project.
