UMngeni-UThukela Water intends to buy then service to supply and installation of 0.8mm aluminum industrial seven profile to carry a minimum 20 years guarantee at Darvill WWW workshop building.

2. Description of goods/ services required

The supplier must provide blinds as follows:

Materials: Specification

Roof sheeting: 0.9mm Aluminium industrial seven profile with a minimum of 20 years guarantee fixed to steel purlins/ lip channel complete with flashing fixed.

The profile shall be rolled formed with 8 trapezoidal ribs at 127mm centres with nett cover of 889mm

The rid height shall be 38mm and shall be fixed in accordance with the manufacture's recommendation

Supply and delivery – 0.8mm aluminium industrial seven profile sheeting with accessories

Installation- either single or multiple sheets within the existing roof with screw fixing to exist roof structure.

Aluminium counter flashing 13 x 30x 142

Aluminium side flashing 154 x 270 x 38

Aluminium ridge capping 0.5mm x 0.5mm x 0.8mm thickness
