TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR PROPOSALS: MUNICIPAL DEBT COLLECTION SERVICES.

It is the intention of the Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality to enter into a service agreement with a service provider that will carry out the services described hereunder. These Terms of Reference and the service provider's proposal will form the basis of the contract.

SECTION 1: DETAILS

Province : Limpopo

Municipality : Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality

Project Name : MUNICIPAL DEBT COLLECTION SERVICES.

SECTION 2: SUMMARY BRIEF

Proposals are requested from service providers who have the necessary stature, extensive experience and qualifications for the Proposals: Municipal Debt Collection.

SECTION 3: PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Tenders are hereby invited for the proposals in respect of MUNICIPAL DEBT COLLECTION.

THE SCOPE OF WORK:

The project scope and methodology should demonstrate the understanding of the assignment, the capacity, capability and the processes that will be followed to implement the project.

It is therefore anticipated that the project should as a minimum requirement meet but "not limited to" the following:

DEBT COLLECTION SERVICES

The pre-legal debt collection services for the collection of revenue on overdue accounts of 90 days and above, on a commission basis, include the following:

- a) Develop a more focused debt collection strategy to help reduce cost save time and maximize recoveries.
- b) Debtor identification through an arrears extract or preferably through an interface with Elias Motsoaledi Municipality's system.
- c) Filtering 90 days arrears information for import into the Service Provider's system,
- d) Also be available to be on-site twice a week to ensure thorough communication and skills transfer on debtor related matters.
- e) Soft and hard tracing,
- f) Letter of demand,
- g) Telephonic, email and SMS interaction with debtors,
- h) Negotiating acceptable payment agreements in accordance with the Credit Control and Debt Collection Policy, such agreements will apply to all debt arrangements,
- Follow up on negotiated agreements,
- j) Identification of defaults on negotiated agreements.

The legal debt collection services for the collection of revenue on overdue accounts interpreted and handed off for legal collection, on a per service billing, include the following:

- a) Soft and hard tracing
- b) Preparation of summons
- c) Obtaining judgements

Preparation of reports according to time frames as set out below:

Monthly Reports

- a) Arrangements made for domestic, businesses and indigents
- b) Final demands issued delivered and posted
- c) Billing and account queries
- d) Correspondence handled with debtors
- e) Payment level statistics

Quarterly Reports

- a) Matters handed over and handed over statistics
- b) Workflow statistics for all actions
- c) The contractor's performance during that financial quarter
- d) A comparison with targets of and with performance in the previous financial quarter
- e) The development of performance targets set by the Contractor for the following quarter

- f) Measures that were or are to be taken into account to improve performance and
- g) Prior to the effective date and quarterly thereafter in conjunction with designated municipal Manager or his nominee, to perform a quarterly assessment of the current situation by
 - i. Identifying possible constraints and developing plans to overcome the constraints
 - ii. An analysis of Elias Motsoaledi Municipality's outstanding debtor's book
 - iii. Recommendations in terms of improved customer care, and
 - iv. Proposed specific projects, the area of focus, resources required and proposed outcomes.

SECTION 4: TERMINATION AND PENALTIES

The service provider is expected to deliver all equipment's and material as required, failure to do so will result in penalties imposed or termination of the contract.

SECTION 5: PROJECT COSTS / PRICING SCHEDULE AND PAYMENT MILESTONES

Service providers are expected to provide an estimate of disbursements in their proposal and indicate payment at specific milestones successfully completed. The project cost must be inclusive of all chargeable costs to the municipality. The municipality will not pay any amount outside the projected/quoted amount.

The proposal must be fixed cost and remain valid for **90 days** after the closing date of the tender submissions. The rate of exchange of this bid is not subject to any foreign currency and the prize must be firm.

SECTION 6: REPORTING

The successful supplier will be expected to submit a detailed quarterly report to Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality on an annual basis (1 copy to Project Manager and another copy to Revenue Management Unit). Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality's Project Manager shall conduct yearly performance assessment to the appointed Service Provider.

SECTION 7: PROJECT TEAM

CV's of the project team must be included in the proposal. Project team must be available for the whole implementation of the project. Declaration letters of availability of the team members must be attached, and in case of resignation of the member the service provider must inform the municipality in writing. The resigned member must be replaced by team member of the same statue e.g., Qualification and experience in consultation with the municipality
