Overberg Water Board is a Schedule 3B Public Entity established in terms accordance with the Water Services Act, Act No 108 of 1997 and owns several Water treatment schemes within the Overberg Region covering the areas of Caledon, Swelledam, Heildelberg and Head Office which is situated in Somerset West.

# **INVITATION AND SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Overberg Water (OW) is inviting bidders to provide technical support for infrastructure maintenance, management, repairs, design reviews and approvals, including overall oversight on repairs and maintenance for a period of 6 months.

# **CONDITIONS**

- (a) Preference will be given to respondents who comply with the Overberg Water Supply Chain Management Policy & Procedures.
- (b) Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) principles and its Regulations, as updated, shall apply, whereby submissions will be evaluated according to the provisions of that Act, its Regulations and the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA).
- (c) Bidders must submit a valid BBBEE Verification Certificate from SANAS Accredited Verification Agency in order to be eligible for empowerment points. The Exempted Micro Enterprises (EME) may submit a sworn affidavit from the Commissioner of Oath confirming its and turnover and black shareholding.
- (d) The following scores will be applied:

(e) Price - 80,

(f) BBBEE Status - 20.

### 1. BACKGROUND

Overberg Water Board has been encountering a number of water and wastewater infrastructure challenges related to day to day operations and maintenance of the infrastructure. This has led to water users or forums representing water users raising complaints attributed to infrastructure failure and overall performance. In addition to these, some of the challenges include:

- a. Frequent pipe bursts and water losses;
- b. Substandard work on pipe repairs or replacement;
- c. Telemetry system neither functioning nor reliable. Put simply it is outdated
- d. Inaccurate dosing resulting in high aluminium levels;
- e. Meter monitoring, replacement and management
- f. Not having access to reliable and dedicated mechanical and electrical services

It is within this context that the Water Board decided to secure services of external service provider toprovide additional capacity to the Water Board.

# 2. PURPOSE OF THE TECHNICAL SUPPORT

- The purpose of this technical support is to seek support for infrastructure maintenance, management, repairs, design reviews and approvals, including overall oversight on repairs and maintenance
- Technical skills and knowledge transfer

# 3. SCOPE OF WORK

# 3.1. Infrastructure Maintenance, Management, Repairs, Design Reviews and Approvals

The successful bidder is expected to provide support in the following areas:

- Water and wastewater infrastructure components
- Provide support or oversee the installation of both new and old water and wastewater infrastructure in all Overberg Water infrastructure network.
- Oversee repairs and or replacement of Overberg Water infrastructure.
- Provide planning and feasibility reports on raw water demand management
- Review and approve water and wastewater infrastructure design and when such designs are presented by any service provider appointed by Overberg Water Board.

- Compile terms of reference for procurement of components of new infrastructure and appointment of services providers for either repairs, maintenance and installation of any new infrastructure.
- Provide overall infrastructure planning and development plans for new infrastructure.
- Develop and or update / review infrastructure plans for existing and new infrastructure.
- Play a strategic role in revenue enhancement through smart meter installation including commissioning and management, installation and maintenance of telemetry system,
- Optional activities :
  - In areas where there is no network, explore installation of satellite communications infrastructure technology.
  - Explore alternative water resources
  - Apply for water use licenses
  - Explore renewable energy in the form of solar panels or solar farms.
- Compile and submit monthly reports to the CEO as per the CEO's requirements and business needs.

# 3.2. Overall Oversight on Infrastructure Repairs and Management by External Service Provider

The successful bidder is expected to provide the following services

- provide overall oversight on all infrastructure repairs and management of external services providers.
- Compile and submit monthly reports to the CEO as per the CEO's requirements and business needs.
- Compile terms of reference for repairs and maintenance of the existing infrastructure

# 3.3. Technical Skills and Knowledge Transfer to Technical Staff

The Overberg Water Board shall identify the relevant individuals who will be capacitated during the project implementation.

# 3.4. Project Team Experience and Technical Capacity Requirements

Even though the Water Board does not expect a big team, the core technical team requirements areas follows:

a. **Programme Director :-** A water expert and experienced construction project manager, registered with the South African Council for Construction and Project Management Professions

("SACPCMP") or Professional Engineer with Pr Tech Eng/ Pr Eng in one of the following engineering discipline (Mech/Civil/Electrical) and also registered with ECSA and with experience relating to overseeing bulk water infrastructure repairs and maintenance and new development. The water expert / Programme Director must be able to interact with key stakeholders, mainly farmers or water forum in the supply area of Overberg Water Board.

- b. **Project Engineer :-** The water expert must be able to provide training on construction and projectmanagement to selected staff members in the duration of the contract. The Project Engineer minimum qualification must be professional engineer with a BEng/BSC in Civil/Mech/Elect as well as registration with ECSA (with experience relating to overseeing bulk water infrastructure repairs and maintenance and new development).
- c. **Junior Engineer**: The Engineer minimum qualification must be BTech Eng. In Civil/Mech/ Elect as well as registration with ECSA (with experience relating to overseeing bulk water infrastructure repairs and maintenance and new development).

Any water specialist or engineer who is not registered with a relevant statutory body will not be considered.

# 4. DURATION OF THE PROJECT

The project will run for six (6) months period from start to completion.

# 5. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

The bidder to provide activity – budget based for a period of 6 months.

- Evaluation Method 2, which entails the balance between Functionality, Financial offer and Price & Preferences 80/20 points system, will be adopted as follows;
- Functionality Points = max 100 points (Minimum threshold=65%)
- Price=80 points (tenders will be awarded a maximum of 80 points for price)
- Preference (B-BBEE) = 20 points

### **Evaluation criteria**

The 80/20 preference points system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 Pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, (ACT NO 5 OF 2000) (PPPFA) will be applied to evaluate this bid. The lowest acceptable bid will score 80 points for price and a maximum of 20 points will be awarded for attaining the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Status Level of Contribution. Bids received will be evaluated on the three (3) phases namely **Mandatory Requirements**, **Functionality Compliance / Specification Compliance** and **Price and Preference**.

# Phase 2: Technical Functionality Compliance.

Bidders must score at least 65 out of 100 in respect of functionality in order to qualify for advancement to Phase 3. A bidder that scores less than 65 out of 100 will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive bid and will be disqualified. Bidders who fail to obtain a minimum score for each criterion will be disqualified.

A bidder must meet 65 out of 100 on technical mandatory requirements.

Functionality evaluation will be based on the criteria in the following table:

# RETURNABLE SCHEDULE 7: CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION (SBD 9)

- 1 This Standard Bidding Document (SBD) must form part of all bids<sup>1</sup> invited.
- 2 Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).<sup>2</sup> Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.

- 1. No RFP will be considered unless submitted on the official Contract Form together with all Returnable Schedules duly completed and signed.
- 2. RFP's can be deposited in the tender box on or before the stipulated closing date and before the closing time at the Overberg Water Board's Corporate Office, situated at Ground Floor, Trident Park 3, 1 Niblick Street, Somerset West, 7137, Cape Town.
- 3. Overberg Water reserves the right to accept the whole quotation or part thereof, or any item or part of any item, or to accept more than one quotation (in the event of a number of items being offered).
- 4. Overberg Water reserves the right to accept an RFQ which is not substantially or materially different from the Specification.
- 5. Overberg Water is not obliged to accept the lowest or any RFQ
- 6. Overberg Water shall not consider RFQ's which are received after the closing date and time for such RFQ's.
- 7. Overberg Water will not be held responsible for any expenses incurred by manufaturers in preparing and submitting RFQ's.
- 8. Overberg Water may, after the closing date, request additional information or clarification from manufaturers, in writing. - 9. Any RFP submitted shall remain valid, irrevocable and open for acceptance by Overberg Water for a period of 60 days from the closing date.
- 10. A Supplier(s) may request in writing, and after the closing date, that his or her RFQ be withdrawn, which withdrawal will be permitted or refused at the sole discretion of Overberg Water after consideration of the reasons for the withdrawal, which shall be set out by the Supplier(s) in such a written request for withdrawal.
- 11. All manufaturers submitting quotations must be registered on National Treasury Central Supplier(s) Database (CSD) as Overberg Water will not award any bid for price quotation to a bidder(s) not registered on the CSD. - 12. If the Supplier(s) is an employer as defined in the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, Act 130 of 1993 (COIDA), the Supplier(s) shall submit either a Letter of Good Standing issued by the Compensation Commissioner in terms of the COIDA, confirming that the Supplier(s) is registered as an employer in terms of the COIDA; or confirmation of cover with a licenced compensation insurerfor the full extent of the Supplier(s)'s potential liability as contemplated in terms of Section 84 of the COIDA.
- 13. No person who is a provider or prospective provider of goods or services, or a recipient or prospective recipient of goods disposed of or to be disposed of may directly or indirectly influence or interferewith the work of any Overberg Water officials involved in the procurement process in order, *inter alia*, to:

- 14. Abuse of the supply chain management system is not permitted and may result in the quotation being rejected, cancellation of the contract, 'blacklisting', and/or any such remedies as set out in Overberg Water's SCM Policy.
- 15. Manufaturers are required to complete all declarations in the Returnable Schedules attached hereto, failing which the quotation may be declared non-responsive.
- 16. An 80/20 price/preference points system will be applied to the evaluation of responsive quotations, whereby the order(s) will be placed with the Supplier(s)(s) scoring the highest total number of adjudication points.
- 16.1 Price shall be scored as follows:

Where: Ps is the number of points scored for price;

Pt is the comparative price of the quotation under consideration; Pmin is the comparative price of the lowest responsive quotation.

## 16.2 Preference points shall be scored as follows:

- a) Points will be awarded to Bidders who are eligible for preferences in respect of B-BBEE contribution in terms of Returnable Schedule 3: Preferencing Schedule.
- b) The terms and conditions of Schedule 3 shall apply in all respects to the quotation evaluation process and to any subsequent contract.
- c) A maximum of 10 quotation evaluation points will be awarded for preference to manufaturers with responsive quotations who are eligible for such preference, in accordance with the criteria listed below.

# PART C: GENERAL & SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

THESE SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (SCC) SUPPLEMENT AND MUST BE READ WITH THE CORRESPONDING PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC) (download at <a href="http://www.treasury.gov.za/divisions/ocpo/sc/GeneralConditions">http://www.treasury.gov.za/divisions/ocpo/sc/GeneralConditions</a>) WHICH SHALL CONSTITUTE THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN OVERBERG WATER AND THE SUPPLIER(S).

# 1. Acceptance/Contract Commencement and purchase orders

The Supplier(s)'s offer will be accepted by Overberg Water when a purchase order and/or letter of appointment is issued to the Supplier(s). The date of issue of the purchase order and/or letter of appointment shall be the commencement date of the contract. The Supplier(s) undertakes work and incurs expenses prior to the issuing of a purchase order and/or letter of appointment entirely at its own risk. Overberg Water shall only incur liability for payment in terms of this contract if a valid purchase order and/or letter of appointment has been issued to the Supplier(s).

## 2. Standards

Failure to comply with the Specification and standards as set out in the quotation document shall constitute a material breach, and Overberg Water reserves the right to cancel the contract in terms of Clause 23 of the GCC.

# 3. Payment- Clause 16 of the GCC

- 3.1 A monthly payment cycle will be the norm. All invoices received for goods and services dated on or before the 20th of a particular month will typically be paid between the 23rd and the 26th of the ensuing month.
- 3.2 More frequent payment to manufaturers is not a right.Requests for such payments will be considered at the sole discretion of Overberg Water.
- 3.3 In order to give effect to a more frequent payment cycle (if approved), an additional mid-month payment run will be effected as necessary. The additional payment run dates will be between the 10th and the 13th of the month.
- 3.4 The actual payment run dates will be dependent on the number of days of the month and the influence of public holidays. Manufaturers on a 14-day cycle who submit invoices by the 25th of a particular month will be paid between the 10th and the 13th of the next month.

# 4. Applicable Law - Clause 30 of GCC

4.1 The Supplier(s) must comply with the Basic Conditions of Employment Act, Act 75 of 1997 and Amendments including all laws relating to wages and conditions governing the employment of labour and Bargaining Council agreements.

# 5. Insurance - Clause 11 of GCC

- 5.1 Without limiting the obligations of the Supplier(s) in terms of this contract, the Supplier(s) shall effect and maintain the following insurances:
- a) Any goods supplied to Overberg Water by the Supplier(s) in terms of this Agreement shall be fully and adequately insured by the Supplier(s) against any loss or damage incidental to manufacture or acquisition, transportation, storage and delivery.
- 5.2 The Supplier(s) shall be obliged to furnish Overberg Water with proof of such insurance.
