TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO CONDUCT AN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AUDIT FOR THE SOUTH AFRICAN DIAMONDS AND PRECIOUS METALS REGULATOR (SADPMR)

1. INTRODUCTION

The South African Diamond and Precious Metals is a Schedule 3A entity of government charged with the mandate of regulating the buying and selling of diamonds and precious metals.

Section 51 (1) (a) (ii) of the Public Finance Management Act 1999 (herein after referred to as the PFMA) states that an accounting authority for a public entity must ensure that the public entity has and maintains a system of internal audit under the control and direction of an audit and risk committee, complying with and operating accordance with regulations and instructions prescribed in terms of section 76 and 77.

2. PROJECT BACKGROUND

Internal Audit is an independent, objective assurance and consulting activity designed to add value and improve organisations' operations. It helps an organisation accomplish its objectives by bringing a systematic, disciplined approach to evaluate and improve the effectiveness of risk management, control and governance processes"

The objective of internal audit also includes the review and evaluation of the adequacy and effectiveness of controls supporting the integrity and confidentiality of the SADPMR admin system (WEB Admin), including all relevant data and information, Information Security and Network.

The SADPMR requires the service of an independent service provider to conduct an Information Technology audit.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The audit should encompass a review of all controls, within the SADPMR admin system (WEB Admin), Information Security and Network. Required to achieve the following key audit objectives:

INFORMATION SECURITY AND NETWORK

- ICT Security policy/procedure and network diagram
- Patch management procedures
- Screen dump of the Anti-virus page
- Evidence of testing for backup tapes



- Back up movement register
- Contract for backup tapes storage (if vendor is utilised)

WEBADMIN

- · authentication and authorisation,
- · segregation of duties, and
- · availability of application data.

The audit should also include Computer Assisted Audit Techniques (CAATs) procedures within the finance division on all SCM processes and Revenue (a reconciliation between Pastel and Web admin system to verify that all revenue has been accounted for)
