- 3. The period and areas of the tender may be changed within the period depending on the availability of funds. The duration of the project and scope must be negotiable if and when necessary.  - a. Herbicide it is the responsibility of the service provider to collect the herbicide from the Municipality.
 - b. The Municipality will not supply warning signs, safety nets and any/all other PPE.
- 5. The Contractor as employer of the Team leaders / general workers is responsible for their occupational health and safety and as much provide personal protective clothing and equipment needed.

1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.
