Please note that Transnet reserves the right to: modify the RFQ's goods / service(s) and request Respondents to re-bid on any changes; reject any Quotation which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein; disqualify Quotations submitted after the stated submission deadline; not necessarily accept the lowest priced Quotation or an alternative bid; place an order in connection with this Quotation at any time after the RFQ's closing date; award only a portion of the proposed goods / services which are reflected in the scope of this RFQ; split the award of the order/s between more than one Supplier/Service Provider should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations; cancel the quotation process; validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. 10 Specification/Scope of Work

Transnet seeks to appoint a competent and experienced service provider for the provision of cleaning and gardening at 10B Kerk Street, Pinetown on an "as and when" required basis for a period of three (3) years.

10.1 Background and Specification

The Service Provider is required to provide all the tools of trade and signage, including but not limited to, machinery, brooms, mops, all cleaning chemicals, rags, disinfectants, buckets etc to perform the services.

The Service Provider shall provide their own uniform, including name tags and Person Protective Equipment (PPE).

Transnet will make available to the Service Provider the storeroom for tools of trade. The Service Provider is required to always keep the storeroom neat and tidy.

Tools of trade, including mops, brooms, brushes, buckets, vacuum cleaners, etc. must always be in safe storage when not in use in the storage.

The Service Provider will report directly to the Transnet Training Manager.

- a) Two female cleaner, one male cleaner and one male gardener are required to carry out the services.
- b) The staff provided by the Service Provider will report directly to the Transnet Training Manager
- c) The staff must be in the Service Provider's uniform, with their name tag visible.
- d) Cleaning staff and gardening staff shall not clean computer terminals or any related computer equipment
- e) Minor building defects must be brought to the attention of the Facilities Manager, these include defects such as defective plug points, light switches, leaking taps, pipes, urinals, etc.
- f) The service provider must provide SABS safety harnesses and attachments for the safe cleaning of windows.
- g) Extension cords must be of the acceptable amperage and subject to inspection by Transnet's campus Health and Safety Representative

11 Legal review

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

12 Security clearance

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the goods and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

13 National Treasury's Central Supplier Database

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Transnet is required to ensure that price quotations are invited and accepted from prospective bidders listed on the CSD. Business may not be awarded to a respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD. The CSD can be accessed at https://secure.csd.gov.za/.

For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 Form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.


14 Tax Compliance

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table indicated in Section 4.1 of the B-BBEE Preference Points Claim Form.

1.4 STEP FOUR: Post Tender Negotiations

Respondents are to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market-related. In this regard, Transnet reserves the right to engage in PTN with the view to achieving a market-related price or to cancel the tender. Negotiations will be done in a sequential manner i.e.:

first negotiate with the highest ranked bidder or cancel the bid, should such negotiations fail, negotiate with the 2nd and 3rd ranked bidders (if required) in a sequential manner.

In the event of any Respondent being notified of such short-listed/preferred bidder status, his/her bid, as well as any subsequent negotiated best and final offers (BAFO), will automatically be deemed to remain valid during the negotiation period and until the ultimate award of business.

Should Transnet conduct post tender negotiations, Respondents will be requested to provide their best and final offers to Transnet based on such negotiations. Where a market related price has been achieved through negotiation, the contract will be awarded to the successful Respondent(s).

1.5 STEP FIVE: Award of business and conclusion of contract

Immediately after approval to award the contract has been received, the successful or preferred bidder(s) will be informed of the acceptance of his/their Quotation by way of a Letter of Award. Thereafter the final contract will be concluded with the successful Respondent(s).

Otherwise, a final contract will be concluded and entered into with the successful Bidder at the acceptance of a letter of award by the Respondent.

16 Validity Period

Transnet requires a validity period of 180 Business Days from the closing date of this RFQ, excluding the first day and including the last day.

Bidders are to note that they may be requested to extend the validity period of their bid, on the same terms and conditions, if the internal evaluation process has not been finalised within the validity period. However, once the adjudication body has approved the process and award of the business to the successful bidder(s), the validity of the successful bidder(s)' bid will be deemed to remain valid until a final contract has been concluded.

Johannesburg Stock Exchange Debt Listing Requirements

Transnet may also be required to disclose information relating to the subsequent contract i.e. the name of the company, goods/services provided by the company, the value and duration of the contract, etc. in compliance with the Johannesburg Stock Exchange (JSE) Debt Listing Requirements.

Domestic Prominent Influential Persons (DPIP) OR Foreign Prominent Public Officials (FPPO)

Transnet is free to procure the services of any person within or outside the Republic of South Africa in accordance with applicable legislation. Transnet shall not conduct or conclude business transactions, with any Respondents without having:

Considered relevant governance protocols;

Determined the DPIP or FPPO status of that counterparty; and

Conducted a risk assessment and due diligence to assess the potential risks that may be posed by the business relationship.
