Framework contract for panel of five service providers for supply and delivery of tools, pipes and fitting to repair and replace burst pipes for a period of two (02) years

Details of the tender: panel of five service providers for supply and delivery of tools, pipes and fitting to repair and replace burst pipes for a period of two (02) years
(SCM/BID17/2025/2026)

We approach this bid through a framework contract due to the fact that the work regarding the panel of five service providers for supply and delivery of tools, pipes and fitting to repair and replace burst pipes for a period of two (02) years is a lot of effort and it is with this in mind that we believe that due to enhancing access to opportunities the municipality is offering, this bid be distributed to different providers.

We will enforce contract management by keeping the details of expenditure for the purpose of monitoring the progress of work done and to advance the spirit of fairness as enshrined in Section 217 of the Constitution. Secondly, we intend to have the job be distributed equitably amongst the service providers participating in the panel and to ensure that the process is completed transparently.

Awarding the work:

We will approach this panel in two different ways as follows;

1. Rotation approach - the work will be distributed among a pre-qualified pool of service providers. The objective is to ensure fairness, transparency, discourage collusion and avoid piling few service providers with contracts whereas others are no receiving anything.

2. We will continue with the request for quotations (RFQs) process. In this regard, whenever there is any request we will still request quotations from all service providers in the pool, where the highest scoring bidder, provided that they meet all requirements and their tax matters are compliant, they will be awarded the job. However, where we find the requirements are not met or if there is another work awarded to the service provider in a similar panel and that they have yet to deliver the service, then the second highest bidder will be considered.
