#### **NOTES**

#### **Note 1: Academic Qualifications**

Proof of academic qualifications in the form of copies must be attached to all personnel. Foreign qualifications must be accompanied by a certificate from Qualifications Certification Body, namely SAQA (South African Qualifications Authority). Failure to provide this proof of academic qualifications will result in the Personnel being regarded as not having minimum prescribed qualifications and will eliminate tender from further evaluation.

### **Note 2: Professional Registration**

Proof of professional Registration with South African Geomatics Council in terms of section 40 of the Geomatics Professions Act, 2013 (Act No. 19 of 2013) or South African Council of Professional and Technical Surveyors (PLATO) Act 40 of 1984 as a Technologist Surveyor in the form of copies must be attached to the Registered Technologist Surveyor CV. Failure to provide this shall warrant an automatic elimination of tender from any further evaluation.

#### Note 3: Experience after qualification

A minimum of 3 years post qualification experience is required for the team leader. More than 3 years post qualification experience is not an eliminating factor but carries more points.

## Note 4 : Employment History Involvement in comparable projects

Attached CV for key personnel must clearly indicate experience and number of years in the field. Proof of employment history must be contained in the Curriculum Vitae (CV) and must include references and contact details. The CV must also show full time (current) employment history. The CV must contain only necessary and relevant information for the purpose of this project (not marital status, hobbies, number of children, etc.).

### **Note 5: Current Employment**

Confirmation of current employment in the form of letter from Supervisor must be attached. In the event a team leader/Project Directors is his/her own supervisor, a letter confirming same must still be attached. The proposed Team Leader shall be a Senior Employee, an associate, the Director, or a Shareholder and in the direct employ of the consulting firm. A proof or separated written confirmation must be attached to the CV. Where a proposed Team Leader is seconded from a rival Consulting Firm, an agreement between the two entities as well as a written undertaking confirming the person's full time availability for the duration of the project must be attached to the CV.

#### Note 6: Company's previous completed projects

Provide proof of completion certificate & the appointment letter reflecting the amount of the project appointed for.

#### **Note 7: Hardware Resources**

Company's asset register with the required listed resources in the form of certified copies must be attached.

#### **Note 8: Software Resources**

A company's asset register with the required listed resources must be attached.

#### Note 9: Company's Vehicles

A company's vehicles registration documents in the name of the company or the directors with the required listed resources must be attached.

# 21.2 Technical adjudication and General Criteria

Tenders will be adjudicated in terms of inter alia:

- i. Compliance with Tender conditions.
- ii. Technical specifications

If the Tenderer does not comply with the Tender Conditions, the Tenderer may be rejected. If technical specifications are not met, the Tender may also be rejected.

Regarding the above, certain actions or errors are unacceptable and warrants **REJECTION OF THE TENDER**, for example.

 A Tax Compliance letter with a unique PIN in terms of the electronic Tax Compliance Status (TCS) system from SARS must been submitted.

- Pages to be completed, removed from the Tender document, and have therefore not been submitted.
- If tender document is not fully completed as required and as stipulated in the tender data.
- If any tender document is tempered with or it is unbinded or unbundled.
- Failure to complete the schedule of quantities as required only lump sums provided.
- Scratching out without initialling next to the amended rates or information.
- Writing over / painting out rates / the use of tippex or any erasable ink, e.g., pencil.
- The Tender has not been properly signed by a party having the authority to do so, according to the Form E "Authority for Signatory".
- A Resolution by a Board of Directors of the Company authorizing the Tenderer to sign the Tender document on behalf of the Company. No authority for signatory submitted.
- Particulars required in respect of the Tender have not been provided non-compliance of Tender requirements and/or specifications.
- The Tenderer's attempts to influence or has in fact influenced the evaluation and/or awarding
  of the contract.
- The Tender has been submitted after the relevant closing date and time.
- Failure to complete and sign Form C1.1 Form of Offer and Acceptance
- If any municipal rates and taxes or municipal service charges owed by that Tenderer or any of its directors to the municipality, or to any other municipality or municipal entity, are in arrears for more than three months.

If any Tenderer who during the last five years has failed to perform satisfactorily on a previous contract with the municipality or any other organ of state after written notice was given to that Tenderer that performance was unsatisfactory

- o Educational qualifications
- o Professional Registrations
- Relevant experience (actual duties performed, involvement and responsibility), including locations, dates and durations of assignments, starting with the latest.
- Language proficiency and
- o References (company name, individual name, position held, contact details)
