1. COMPANY BACKGROUND

Denel is a South African State-Owned Company (SOC) that provides innovative defence, security, aerospace and related technology solutions, as a strategic partner to the South African National Defence Force (SANDF). The state-owned but commercially driven company provides a wide range of sophisticated services and solutions that enhance the value of its products for the export market globally.

Denel's solutions are designed to meet unique user requirements and provide full lifecycle support. Its products and capabilities include conceptualising, designing, developing, integrating and supporting artillery, munitions, missiles, aircraft maintenance, unmanned aerial vehicle systems and optical payloads based on high-end technology. Its defence capabilities date back more than 70 years when some of Denel's first manufacturing plants were established.

other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
