1. INSPECTION

2. SUBMISSION OF THE “OFFER TO PURCHASE”

Please note the following rules with respect to the OLT system (Informal Tendering)

- a. Please ensure that the email subject line only contains the OLT11xxxxx Enquiry number as per heading and no other information. Do not add any text to the subject line. Do not add any space in between the prefix and the enquiry number.
- b. **Closing Date: 28/09/2023 at 10:00**
- c. Ensure that the enquiry number is stipulated in the subject line on all e-mails if multiple emails are sent.
- d. Ensure that you receive a confirmation email after submitting your documentation. Please follow up immediately via the email address of the respective buyer if you did not receive this.
- e. **Maximum attachment size per email is 10MB**. It is the supplier's obligation to ensure that the attachments per email do not exceed this limit.
- f. Please note closing date and time on the RFQ. Your submission will not be evaluated if it is received after the closing date and time of the RFQ.

g. All tender returnables/documentation must be submitted to Informaltendering@eskom.co.za only.

E-mails to any other address (except for clarifications) will not be accepted.

Failure to comply with these rules will result in your tender being disqualified.

h. Requests for Clarifications must be sent in writing to the respective buyer at dtoitm@eskom.co.za and not to Informaltendering@eskom.co.za.

All requests for clarifications and responses must be in writing. Eskom will respond to requests for clarification received within one (1) – two (2) working days before the tender closing deadline, depending on the enquiry duration and complexity.

3. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF TENDER

- Please quote the tender enquiry number on any correspondence.
- Please take note of the STANDARD CONDITIONS OF TENDER, (July 2000) noted in this letter and any amendments that accompany the TENDER ENQUIRY **OLT2088636**. The tenderer should understand that his / her signed Offer to Purchase serves as his legal agreement to the Standard conditions of tender.
- Tenderers must abide by Eskom's Safety & Security requirements at all sites. Eskom is not liable for any injuries to tenderers or their agents during the removal process.
- Collection must take place for Transformer 13 first, and upon confirmed quantity and payment, before Transformer 12 oil can be collected. Payment is to be made by electronic transfer by **no later than 5 days** from the date of notification of the confirmed quantity of oil.

4. RISK

Risk in and to the oil shall pass to the successful tenderer immediately upon payment of the goods.

5. OWNERSHIP

Collection of the oil for transformer 12 will only take place after full payment has been received for Transformer 13 oil. Ownership of the oil shall pass to the purchaser against the receipt of payment of the full purchase price.

6. COLLECTION DATE

The collection date **MUST commence within 1 week** and/or by mutual agreement with the Eskom representative.

7. GUARANTEE / WARRANTY

Eskom Holdings Limited gives no guarantee or warranty to the workability or condition of the oil on sale. The equipment is sold "Voetstoots".

8. OFFERS

Offers received will be deemed valid for a period of 2 month (60 days) from tender closing date.

Eskom reserves the right not to accept the highest or any tender / offer or withdraw any item it wishes to retain.

Only successful tenderers will be notified.

9. VALUE ADDED TAX (VAT)

Value Added Tax Act no 89 Of 1991 and VAT invoices will be issued on request.

10. PAYMENT

Eskom Holdings SOC Limited requires payment in cash or by electronic transfer for the total tendered price prior to the removal of the equipment.

Full payment is required by **no later than 5 days** after successful collection of transformer 13 quantified oil, after which collection of transformer 12 oil can be collected.

11. VARIATION

No variation or modification of the proposed agreement shall be in force, unless the same is confirmed in writing.

12. CRITERIA USED FOR EVALUATION OF OFFERS

In terms of the ESKOM Purchasing Pact, the following criteria will be used in the evaluation and awarding of the contract:

Price (Rand value) 80% and BBB-EE 20%. Please indicate the price as Rand per Litre.

13. NOTES

1. Eskom will not be responsible for any damages or losses suffered during the removal of the oil. Oil tankers to be used that can carry +-20 000L of oil at a time, no 1000L containers to be used.
2. You will be required to adhere to the condition as laid out by the Eskom site agent with regards to site access etc.
3. Littering is prohibited at all times. Facilities will have to be made available on site during dismantling operations for the collection of disposal waste material. No rubble whatsoever is to be left on site.
4. Additional precautions must be taken when using cutting equipment. Portable fire fighting equipment must be available on site during all stages of the work programme.
5. **The oil is sold; and all necessary Environmental precautions and legislation must be adhered to. Successful tenderer to submit all documentation relating to the safe disposal of the oil.**

6. You will be required to be put on an Eskom permit, prior to commencement of and work. After completion of the work, it is imperative that you notify the Eskom site agent, so that the job can be signed off.
7. All work must comply with the OHSA Act no 85 of 1993.
8. All damage done to property due to successful contractor must be reported to Eskom. Repairs to damage will need to be done immediately.
9. Any oil spills caused during the work programme will need to be rehabilitated by the successful contractor.
10. This is an informal tendering tender.
- 11. That a bidder who has an existing or expired contract with Eskom and has defaulted in terms of that contract will be disqualified and not be awarded a new contract**
- 12. That a bidder who has an open non-conformance will be disqualified and not awarded a new contract.**

Management of the sale of mineral oil

- In adopting the cradle-to-grave principle, it is an important consideration to understand the intended use of Eskom's mineral oil by third parties post the sale of oil. Eskom are required to take all reasonable measures to ensure the mineral oil is further processed responsibly such that there is no compromise to human health or environmental impact.
- The Department of Environmental Affairs make provision for the control of all parties dealing with waste to act responsibly and ensure business activities are concluded sustainably. Such control is provided for through the issuing of a waste management licence to parties who wish to beneficiate waste. Parties with a waste management licence will be expected to comply to the conditions of the licence thereby ensuring responsible and sustainable use of the waste stream.
- Eskom's Investment Recovery Department will seek from all interested parties who have expressed an interest in the purchase of mineral oil, a waste management licence or other relevant authorisation as a pre-condition to any sale. The requirement of a waste management licence will facilitate the responsible control, management and beneficiation of Eskom's mineral oil.
- **Sale of mineral oil to transporters**
 - Oil Transporters are not licenced to re-use, recycle or trade in oil without a waste management licence. A waste management licence is not required to transport oil to an authorised waste facility, however legislation soon to be gazetted will require that all transporters of waste be registered with the Department of Environmental Affairs.

- Eskom's Investment Recovery Department will be required to in principle, contract directly with authorised waste facilities for the sale of mineral oil.
- In the event of sale agreements between Eskom and oil transport companies being concluded, these should be conditional to:
 - Copy of the agreement / contract between the transporter and waste facility to whom the oil will be transported.
 - Copy of the waste licence of the facility to whom the oil will be transported.
 - Copy of the oil transporters registration with Department of Environmental Affairs and / or applicable regulatory body eg. Rose foundation.
 - Waste manifest / delivery notes from waste facility on delivery of oil.
