



Provision of an Electronic Board Meeting Management Solution Non-Compulsory Briefing – 21 November 2025

On 21 November 2025, merSETA held a non-compulsory briefing session to address the questions, enquiries and clarifications regarding the advertised tender of the above-mentioned.

The following are the questions raised during the briefing session with answers:

- 1. The terms of reference item number 4.9 where the proposals on the set up and configuration of the system on the merSETA premises. When merSETA references merSETA premises, is it a computer room inside merSETA or is it AWS? has merSETA already migrated its architecture to the cloud?**

Response:

merSETA do have an Azure subscription, so the premises is actually referring to cloud, not on premises.

- 2. Are bidders allowed to propose their own cloud deployment as well, since it seems like merSETA has already adopted the cloud strategy?**

Response:

Annexure C on any other considerations or recommendations, merSETA do make provision for that, but when we do the calculation of the costs, the bidder will then obviously count the ones that are for the installation on our premises. Should the day come where merSETA reconsider, merSETA then have that option as well.
