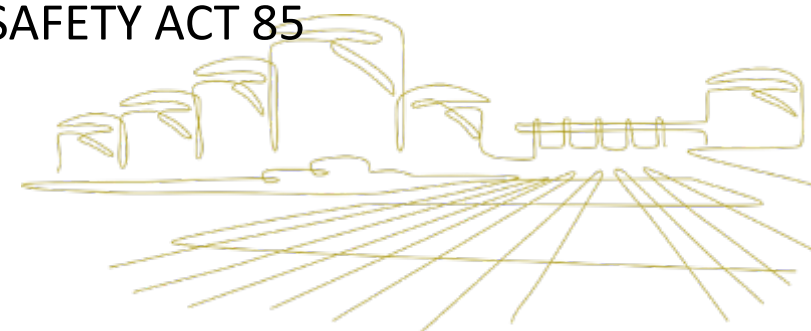

NEW ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION SYSTEM

1. Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

BID SUBMISISON:

- • Log on to the Transnet eTenders management platform website/ Portal ((transnetetenders.azurewebsites.net) Please use **Google Chrome** to access Transnet link/site);
 - Click on "ADVERTISED TENDERS" to view advertised tenders;
 - Click on "SIGN IN/REGISTER – for bidder to register their information (must fill in all mandatory information);
 - Click on "SIGN IN/REGISTER" - to sign in if already registered;
 - Toggle (click to switch) the "Log an Intent" button to submit a bid;
 - Submit bid documents by uploading them into the system against each tender selected.
- 6 No late submissions will be accepted. The bidder guide can be found on the Transnet Portal transnetetenders.azurewebsites.net

- Time your submissions so that if there are any issues, there is time to escalate & resolve

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO SUBMIT TENDER

Only those tenderers who satisfy the following technical eligibility criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

- **Bidders must provide proof of registration as dangerous goods carriers in line with the National Road Traffic Act and ensure that each vehicle used to transport dangerous goods displays a valid “D” category operator card issued with the licence disc.**
- **Valid proof of Driver in possession of a valid PrDP Category “D of Dangerous Goods (D).**

Note: Tenderers who do not comply with both requirements above will be disqualified and will not proceed further to the next stage for further evaluation.

RETURNABLE DOCUMENTS

The Tenderer is also required to submit with the tender:

1. An electronic access PIN from the new Tax Compliance Status system;
2. Tendering Entity's latest **valid** B-BBEE Certificate, certified copy of B-BBEE certificate or Sworn Affidavit applicable as per the latest B-BBEE Legislation must accompany
3. Proof of registration on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database. Go to <https://secure.csd.gov.za/Home/> to register.
4. Letter of Good Standing with the Workmen's compensation fund by the tendering entity or separate Letters of Good Standing from all members of a newly constituted JV.

Tender Evaluations



Stage 1 – Test for administrative and substantive responsiveness

- check that the bid was lodged on time, and that all returnable documents and schedules have been completed and returned by the closing time and date and verify the validity of all returnables.
- check that all pre-qualification criteria set by Transnet has been met, confirm that the bid contains a signed offer and that the bid is materially compliant with the scope and specifications.

Stage 2 – Functionality/Technical Evaluation - Minimum thresholds of 80.

Stage 3 – Evaluation and final weighted scoring – Price 80 / Specific Goals 20

Stage 4 – Post tender negotiations with either one or more.

Tenderer to provide operational procedures on the handling (loading and securing of a load), transportation (compliance with SABS Codes 0231 and 0232), disposal of industrial waste (i.e., unloading procedures), Emergence response plan during transportation, including spill response and incident investigation.			10
Tenderer to provide copies of certificate of employees training on the handling of hazardous chemicals substances or waste handling or waste management.			30
Maximum possible score for Functionality			100

Criteria	Evaluation Approach
Adherence to the Pricing Schedule	• For purpose of evaluation and comparison pricing schedule is predefined • Deviation from the pricing schedule disqualifies the bid • Deviations are considered as changes that render the bidders pricing incomparable such as; • Changing the basis of calculation (e.g. rate based vs. cost/unit); • Exclusions that render the bidder's price non-comparable; • Changing items requested in the pricing schedule • Changing the quantities of items/ resources requested



Considerations

- Adhere to the pricing schedule, No alternative bids can be accepted in the one bid;
- Ensure it all adds up- i.e. arithmetically accurate;

Deviation from the prescribed pricing data will result in the bid being disqualified

All unsuccessful bidders have a right to request Transnet to furnish individual reasons for their bid not being successful
