

**REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A FINANCIAL ADVISORY PANEL OF
FOR A PERIOD FIVE (05) YEARS AT THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND.**

No	Clarification	Response
1.	How should the international qualification be indicated in relation to the SAQA equivalent	It is the responsibility of the bidders to get the SAQA level confirmation from the relevant government institutions if they intending to submit an international qualification.
2.	Can the bidders submit more than one CV for each expert or resource	No, only one CV per resource is required. The bidder must specify the specific role each resource is being nominated for.
3.	Will adviser on the panel be restricted or not permitted based on the potential conflict to advise or participate in similar projects with other parties other than the DBSA – IF	If the bidder is on the panel at the time when an RFP is issued for work on a particular project and the pre-qualified bidder is already involved on work of the same project/s, then they are not eligible for bidding or participating in this process. That would constitute a conflict of interest (directly or indirectly).
4.	Are bidders allowed to be part of more than one different consortium when responding to this panel.	No, they are not allowed as it would be seen as collusive bidding.
