The contract expired on 14 October 2021 without the service provider conducting the third event. The contract could not be extended within the contract validity period, as there was uncertainty about when the lockdown regulations would be relaxed. By appointing Moshate Communications (PTY) Ltd through a single source, SANParks will save time and resources that would be utilized to start the new competitive bidding process as well as avoiding the steep learning curve by the new service provider as the appointment is only for one event in one year. Due to Covid-19 uncertainty and concerns over a 4th wave and insufficient budget, the event may need to be further postponed to be executed in 2022. The services will be paid at the price that was quoted three years back, which is a saving considering the time value of money. National Treasury supports the deviation to allow Moshate Communications (PTY) Ltd to conduct the last event as per the three years' contract signed in 2018.
