PROVISION AND INSTALLATION OF A FIRE DETECTION AND SUPPRESSION SYSTEM FOR THE RECORDS AND ARCHIVE OFFICE

Swartland Municipality awaits quotations from suitably experienced service providers for the Provision and Installation of a Fire Detection and Suppression System for the Records and Archive Office, as specified in the official bid documentation.

A non-refundable cash fee of **R170.00** is payable to Swartland Municipality for collection of **hard copy** tender documents. The tender document is available in electronic format on request, at no charge.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a **SF** class of construction works and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with regulation 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, 2004. It is estimated that tenderers will need a grading designation of **1SF or higher**.

Quotations and all relevant documentation in a sealed envelope, clearly marked “**Tender T21/24/25 – Provision and Installation of a Fire Detection and Suppression System**” must be deposited in the tender box at the Municipal Head Offices, on the cnr of Kerk and Voortrekker Street Malmesbury, before **12h00 on Friday 8 November 2024**. No late quotations, electronic or faxed tenders will be accepted.

A **Compulsory Clarification Meeting** with representatives of the Employer will take place at the **Registry Office (1st Floor)**, Municipal Head Office, Swartland Municipality, 1 Kerk Street in Malmesbury on **Friday, 1 November 2024, at 10:00 (Registration closes at 10:05)**.

Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the Council's Preferential Procurement Policy and the attached specifications. The 80/20-preference point system will be used for the evaluation of the contract. The Preferential Procurement Policy will be available for perusal during normal office hours at the municipal offices. The Swartland Municipality endorses and supports the Government's Black Economic Empowerment Programme and is committed to rectify the inequalities of the past. For bidders to qualify for the advantages of the B-BBEE Act, they must thoroughly complete the attached Annexure MBD 6.1. **There will be no benefits if the schedule is not thoroughly completed. Preference points MUST also be claimed in paragraph 6.1.** Bidders are required to submit **original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies** thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. **Bidders are also required to submit Proof of Locality in order to claim points for locality.** This Bid is subject to the General Conditions of Tender and if applicable, any other Special Conditions of Tender.
