Note 01: Delegation of Authority

In case of a Company, a delegation of Authority signed by the Consulting Firm's Board of Directors nominating a Team Leader as a delegated and authorized Signatory must be attached. In case of a Closed Corporation, a delegation of Authority signed by the Contracting Firm's majority Shareholders nominating a Team Leader as a delegated and authorized Signatory must be attached. Note 02: Completing tender document
