Late, faxed or e-mailed tenders will not be considered.

PLEASE NOTE:

The official Bid document must be fully completed in black ink, all pages must be submitted should preferably be bound.

Supporting documents must be submitted separately and must be stapled or bound.

Only goods and services applicable to local production and content will be considered.

THE ESTIMATED CONTRACT VALUE INDICATES A CIDB REQUIREMENT OF GB3 OR HIGHER.

Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 (Regulation 9. (1) and 9. (3) make provision for the promotion of local production and content. Local production content applicable to designated sectors of construction.

Only goods, works and services with a stipulated minimum threshold as applicable for local production and content will be considered. The South African Bureau of Standards approved, Technical Specification Number (SATS 1286:2011) will be used to calculate local content.
