1.1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1.1.1. SASSETA was established on 1 July 2005. It is one of the twenty-one Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETAs) established in terms of the Skills Development Act (Act 97 of 1998) as amended. SASSETA's licence has been renewed until 31st March 2030. SASSETA is classified as a schedule 3A Public Entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, (Act 1 of 1999, as amended). SASSETA reports to the Department of Higher Education and Training.

1.2. PURPOSE

- 1.2.1. The objective of this bid is to appoint of a service provider to render support and maintenance for Microsoft Great Plains (GP) solution:

1.3. SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.3.1. The scope of work will cover the following areas:
 - 1.3.1.1. The service provider will render support and maintenance for all technical Microsoft GP queries,
 - 1.3.1.2. The service provider will assist with data validation and migration of historical data into a new Microsoft Finance solution, and
 - 1.3.1.3. The service provider will assist with the facilitation of renewing or adding user licenses.

- 1.5.1. This assignment will run from date of appointment until 31st March 2027.

1.6. PRICING

- 1.6.1. A successful bidder will be paid based on the agreed rate in line with SBD3.3.

- 1.7.1. The service provider will report to the Finance Manager.

1.8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 1.8.1. The service provider will be contracting with SASSETA. All products and data of this project, in whatever format raw or analysed, will be the confidential information for utilisation by SASSETA. All information and documents, received from SASSETA or stakeholders, is to be kept confidential and may not be used or distributed in any format without the written approval of SASSETA. To this end, the service provider will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement within the Contract.
