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TENDER NO: NKO: 29/2026: SALE, PURCHASE, CAPTURE, REMOVAL AND RELOCATION OF EXCESS GAME FROM NKOMAZI LOCAL MUNICIPALITY FOR ECOLOGICAL RESTORATION OF MARLOTH PARK DURING THE 2026 GAME CAPTURE SEASON

Nkomazi Local Municipality hereby invites suitably qualified, experienced and capable game capture operators, wildlife traders, game ranchers and other eligible service providers to submit bids for the **purchase, capture, removal and relocation of excess game** from the Nkomazi Local Municipality Marloth Park Nature Reserve.

This tender is an **income-generating disposal process** in terms of the applicable provisions of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (Act No. 56 of 2003), the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations, and the Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy. The successful bidder will purchase the game from the Municipality and shall be solely responsible, at its own cost and risk, for all aspects relating to:

Purchasing the game at the accepted tendered rates; Planning and execution of the capture operations; Provision of all equipment, vehicles, capture teams and veterinary support where required; Loading, transportation and relocation of the animals; Obtaining all permits, approvals and movement documentation required by the relevant conservation authorities; Compliance with all applicable wildlife, veterinary, environmental, occupational health and safety, and relevant animal welfare legislation.

The estimated number of excess games to be disposed are: Giraffe 10, Zebra 40, Blue Wildebeest 20, Kudu 150, Impala 600, Bushbucks 200, Warthog 150. The quantities provided are estimates only and may increase or decrease depending on the outcome of the final game count, operational requirements and environmental considerations.

Tender documentation with complete details is available upon the payment of a non-refundable amount of **R1 858.38d** for each tender document, alternatively they can be downloaded for free on the e-Tender portal. Tender document(s) will be available as from **10/07/2026** and can be obtained at Nkomazi Local Municipality: Budget and Treasury (Old Malalane Taxi Rank) Impala Street from the Cashiers Desk from 07h45 to 15H30 (Monday-Friday).

Non-Compulsory tenderer briefing session will be held on **16/07/2026 at 10H00** at the Municipal Town Hall Malelane (Kobwa Hall) at Fish Eagle. All bidders are advised not to commit fraudulent activities or forgery to documentation. All the abusers of SCM system including faking of returnable documents maybe reported to SAPS and restricted from doing business with any public institution for a period not exceeding 10 years as in line with section 28 and 29 of the prevention and combating of corrupt activities Act 12 of 2024.

A preferential system shall apply whereby this contract will be allocated to bidder in accordance with the preferential procurement policy framework Act no. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the bid document, read in conjunction with the preferential procurement regulation 2022 where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of targeted goals. Completed bid documentation must be deposited on/before **12h00 on 07/08/2026** in the Tender Box situated at the main entrance of the municipality (Civic Centre), 9 Park Street Malalane.

Tenders/Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope or container on which the tender/bid number and addressee is clearly marked. No bids transmitted by fax or e-mail will be accepted. It must be noted that the municipality is not bound to accept the lowest on any other tender. Tender/bid documentation which is incomplete or filled incorrectly, not filled in on the official bid documentation or which is received after the close of the bids, will be ignored. It must also be noted that tender submitted in a wrong tender box will not be considered.
