Specifications

Provided training must match the specs & quantities as described below.

3.1 Gate 0: Administrative (mandatory) requirements

Supplier (s) must submit the documents listed in **Table 1** below. All documents must be completed and signed in black ink by the duly authorised representative of the prospective bidder(s). **Correction fluid is not allowed and any cancellation on the bid document must be initiated by the authorized signatory.**

During this phase, Bidders' responses will be evaluated based on compliance with the listed administration and mandatory bid requirements. The bidder(s) quotation will be disqualified for non-submission of any of the documents.
