1.	What is the scope of concrete repairs under this contract?	The scope includes structural integrity assessment, crack injection, concrete repair, grouting, and debris removal. Repairs will be conducted in collaboration with Eskom engineers..	29/10/2025
2.	Will access platforms be provided or must contractors supply their own?	Platforms will be provided by Eskom where available. Contractors must make provision for additional platforms if required.	29/10/2025
3.	Are rope access repairs expected under this contract?	Yes. Rope access may be required for repairs in vertical shafts and other inaccessible areas.	29/10/2025
4.	What materials are expected for concrete repair?	Materials include bonding agents, cementitious repair products, crack injection grout, and anti-moss concrete. A material list must be submitted on contract award.	29/10/2025

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5.	What safety documentation is required with the tender?	Yes. Daily permit-to-work and safety briefings are mandatory prior to commencing work. Contractors must comply with Eskom's OHS protocols.	29/10/2025
