

ERRATUM AND EXTENSION OF CLOSING DATE**CORRECTION TO FUNCTIONALITY SCORING CRITERIA**

MMSEZ hereby issues this Erratum to correct an error identified in the functionality scoring criteria of the following tenders. The correction is material to the evaluation requirements and is therefore accompanied by an extension of the closing date by fourteen (14) calendar days.

1. Tender Description:

PROVISION OF COMPLETE CIVIL ENGINEERING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE WASTE MANAGEMENT INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE MMSEZ NORTH SITE PHASE 1G

Correction to the Functionality Scoring Criteria:

The tender document states that the Key Civil Engineer must have a minimum of fifteen (15) years' post-qualification experience in Waste Management Design, Construction and Maintenance. However, the corresponding functionality scoring table incorrectly awards points based on experience in Water Services.

The scoring criterion is hereby corrected to reflect experience in Waste Management, as follows:

Experience	Points
Less than fifteen (15) years post-qualification experience in Waste Management	0
Fifteen (15) years or more but less than twenty (20) years post-qualification experience in Waste Management	20
Twenty (20) years or more post-qualification experience in Waste Management	35

Correction to the Functionality Scoring Criteria:

The functionality scoring criterion in the tender document contains an incorrect description of the required experience. The criterion is hereby corrected to reflect post-qualification experience in Roads and Stormwater.

The scoring criterion is hereby amended to read as follows:

Twenty (20) years or more post-qualification experience in Roads and Stormwater	35

Correction to the Functionality Scoring Criteria:

The functionality scoring criterion contains an error in the description of the required experience. The scoring criterion is corrected to reflect experience in Network Engineering or ICT Infrastructure.

The scoring criterion is hereby amended to read as follows:

Experience	Points
Less than fifteen (15) years post-qualification experience in Network Engineering or ICT Infrastructure	0
Fifteen (15) years or more but less than twenty (20) years post-qualification experience in Network Engineering or ICT Infrastructure	20
Twenty (20) years or more post-qualification experience in Network Engineering or ICT Infrastructure	3
