1. PURPOSE OF THE MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this memo is to request approval from the Chief Financial Officer for:

- Renewal of Aruba Clearpass subscription which is a critical component of SALGA's network access control and cybersecurity infrastructure.

2. MOTIVATION AND BACKGROUND

In 2017, SALGA invested in the Aruba ClearPass solution to strengthen its network access control strategy. ClearPass enables secure authentication, role-based access control, and endpoint visibility—ensuring that only compliant and authorized devices gain access to internal network resources. These capabilities have significantly enhanced SALGA's cybersecurity posture by reducing the risk of unauthorized access and data breaches.

In addition, ClearPass provides secure guest Wi-Fi services, allowing seamless and isolated internet access for visitors and stakeholders. The platform supports customized onboarding portals, time-restricted credentials, and policy-based controls, thereby improving user experience while maintaining strict security boundaries.
