



TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER TENDER NUMBER: CI-GK-0189

The South African National Parks invites tenders for **Maintenance and Upgrading of Sections of Gravel Roads in the Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park.**

ELIGIBILITY

CIDB Grading:

- a) Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered, or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, for a **5CE** or higher class of construction work, are eligible to submit tenders:
- b) Contractors registered as potentially emerging enterprises with the CIDB who are registered in one contractor grading designation lower than the required in terms of (a) above who satisfy criteria stipulated in the Tender Data may submit tenders. (**4CEPE**)

SANParks undertakes to support the development of emerging contractors in the construction industry through the use of the Potentially Emerging (PE) policy instrument developed by the CIDB, namely CIDB Standard for Indirect Targeting Model for Enterprise Development.

- c) Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that:
 - (i) every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB;
 - (ii) the lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **5CE** or higher class of construction work; or not lower than one level below the required grading designation in the class of construction works under consideration and possess the required recognition status;
 - (iii) the combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered of **5 CE** class of construction work or a value determined in accordance with the Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations.
- d) Only tenderers who comply with the following are eligible to submit tenders:
 - (i) Have the required and valid CIDB grading stated.
 - (ii) Achieved the minimum score for Functionality
 - (iii) Tenderer is not listed in the Register of Tender Defaulters and prohibited from doing business with the public sector.
 - (iv) The tenderer has not abused the Employer's supply chain management system
 - (v) The tenderer has not failed to perform on any previous contract with the employer.

Functionality Criteria:

Road Construction.

Tenderers are required to score a minimum of **8 points** out of a possible **12 points** in order to be responsive: Refer to Clause **C.3.11.1** in the Tender Data of the proposed functionality criteria and point system for evaluation.

Tender documents will ONLY be available at the COMPULSORY clarification meeting.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the **Conference Room, Park Management offices, Twee Rivieren Rest Camp, Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park 18 &19 March 2025 starting at 11:00.**

The Compulsory Site Clarification meeting will be conducted over 2 days as follows;

18 March 2025 @ 11:00 – Twee Rivieren, Clarification meeting.

19 March 2025 @ 08h00 – Mata Mata, Site of works and borrow pits inspections (departure from Twee Rivieren at 8h00)

It is compulsory for bidders to attend both sessions

SANParks representative will only sign the Site Clarification Attendance in the tender document on 19 March 2025, after the final site visit. Tenders submitted without the signature of the SANParks representative will be deemed non-responsive, disqualified and eliminated from the evaluation process.

It is suggested that 1 night's accommodation be secured at Twee Rivieren Rest Camp or adjacent to the Park, as departure from Twee Rivieren to the Mata Mata will be at 08h00 on 19 March 2025. Bidders must arrange for their own transport for the site visit on the 19 March 2025, a 4X4 or high clearance vehicle is recommended.

Prospective tenderers who arrive later than 11h15 on the 18 March 2025, will not be allowed into the Clarification meeting.

The tenderer must be represented at the site inspection by a person who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implications of the work involved. Attendance of the site inspection is compulsory, and a tender will be disqualified if the site inspection is not attended by a representative of the tenderer.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is 09 April 2025 at 11:00.

must be deposited ONLY in the tender box at Office of the Arid Regional General Manager, Upington. Bi-Lo Office no.6, 9 Groenpunt weg, Upington, on or before the stated closing date and time.
