

T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER (Incorporating SBD1)

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) invites tenders for the provision of professional services for the road safety education and awareness programme on the SANRAL national network.

This project shall be delivered nationally in all nine (9) provinces over a period of three (3) years.

Only those tenderers who are a public South African Universities / Colleges or accredited training providers registered as skills training and development services providers in terms of the Higher Education Act, Act 101 of 1997, meet the minimum requirements for the key persons and are registered on National Treasury Central Supplier Database as detailed in Clause 4.1.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to tender.

Joint Ventures (JV) will be allowed on condition that one JV partner is a Targeted Enterprise. The JV partner will, however, not contribute to sub-contract target for Targeted Enterprises.

Please take note this is a one-envelope system.
