ADDENDUM

Provision Of Pest Control Services – Wood Borer Infestation for the Perishable Products Export Control Board (PPECB).

This addendum refers to the following section of the RFQ:

2.5.2 “Minimum Warranty Period

Duration: The Contractor must provide an unconditional, written 5-year (five-year) warranty against any re-infestation of woodboring beetles or wood-destroying insects within the treated structure.”

The above is revised to read as follows:

2.5.2 Minimum Warranty Period

Duration: The Contractor must provide an unconditional, written 1-year (one-year) warranty against any re-infestation of woodboring beetles or wood-destroying insects within the treated structure.

“Failure to provide the following mandatory documents at the closing date and time will result in immediate disqualification:

- 1. Proof of valid registration with the Department of Agriculture (Act 36 of 1947) as a Pest Control Operator (PCO) in the Structural Fumigation category.*
- 2. Proof of active corporate membership with the South African Pest Control Association (SAPCA) or an equivalent recognized professional body”.*

Point number 1 remains the mandatory requirement.

Point number 2 is not mandatory but optional. Therefore, no bidder will be disqualified for not belonging to voluntary professional bodies.

The changes stated in the addendum will be the new conditions/criteria to be met and evaluated. They override the current criteria in the document.
