	SERVICE PROVIDER QUESTION	SABC ANSWER
1.	How much waste does the SABC produce per month?	The SABC produce the following per month: - The SABC produce approximately 3.5 Tones per month 96% of this Waste is classified as general waste, the remainder is hazardous - Monthly Collection frequencies averages between 8 to 9 times (two collections per week)
2.	I would like to do a follow up based on a question I posed on a briefing session we have online on 06 March 2025, about Evaluation criteria the last point where it speaks about the waste landfill certificate, where I have argued that at landfills they only give us proof of accounts not certificate issued by the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development, then one of your colleague said he will respond with an example for clarity. Can we please be clarified.	All regulated Landfill facilities in the Gauteng province are issued with valid certificates of successful registration with the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development or and Environment. This certificate is issued for the purpose of reporting to the Gauteng Waste Information System. The certificate will reflect a GPL number that the landfill facility uses when reporting received volumes of waste to the Gauteng Waste Information System. It will also reflect a date of registration and the date of expiry. Bidders will get this certificate from the management of the Landfill that they use.

	SERVICE PROVIDER QUESTION	SABC ANSWER
3.	Equipment on Site SABC currently has the below listed items on site owned by the SABC: Please note there were NO Fluorescent Tube Crushers on site? -	Bidders are required to quote on the equipment hire section as per pricing schedule B of the RFP.
4.	Waste Removal Service: Please Note that the BOQ does not make provision for costing of waste removal and frequency.	Bidders must add any other cost and label it D (other) as indicated on 52 of the RFP which read as follows ' TOTAL BID PRICE (A + B+ C+D(Other)) (VAT EXCL)'. Bidder must also be aware of the below: Note: The prices must be inclusive of all costs relating to the effective management of service.
5.	No mention was made to the actual working hours, and I took it would be on the RFQ; however, I only see the head counts. Therefore, if Saturdays and Sundays are included, please share detail with me.	Bidders are requested to read and familiarize themselves with section 8 on page 28 of the RFP document, the working hours are stated on item 8.2.8.
6.	Another question I have is whether Public holidays is indeed included or not?	The Campus is closed on public holidays
