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1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this work scope is to procure the rental of a Pilot boat for the duration of six months.

2. OBJECTIVES

To ensure that the detailed report and recommendations for quotation purposes is achieved.

Emphasis is placed on Transnet's commitment to safety and its objective of Zero Harm and achieving an incident-free.

3. SITE LOCATION

The Pilot Boat is to be on site in the Cape Town harbor. The service provider will report to the Marine Services Department.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

- ❖ Rental of a Pilot Boat in compliance with regulations of SAMSA and the Merchant Shipping Act.
- ❖ Pilot boat is to have all machinery in working condition onboard.
- ❖ Pilot boat is to have all safety equipment functional and serviced with all documentation valid for the duration of the six months.

5. QUALITY AND SERVICE

- All services rendered to Transnet must be of excellent quality in compliance with the specifications. Should the service(s) not be in conformity with the specifications, Transnet reserves the right to reject them, obtain the service(s) from other sources of its free choice and debit the difference in cost, if any, to the Service Provider.
- The Service Provider shall ensure that its employees tasked with providing the required services to Transnet are competent and experienced in carrying out its responsibilities as set out in the scope of work herein

6. HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

All the safety equipment onboard must be operational, in date and have the accompanying paperwork.
