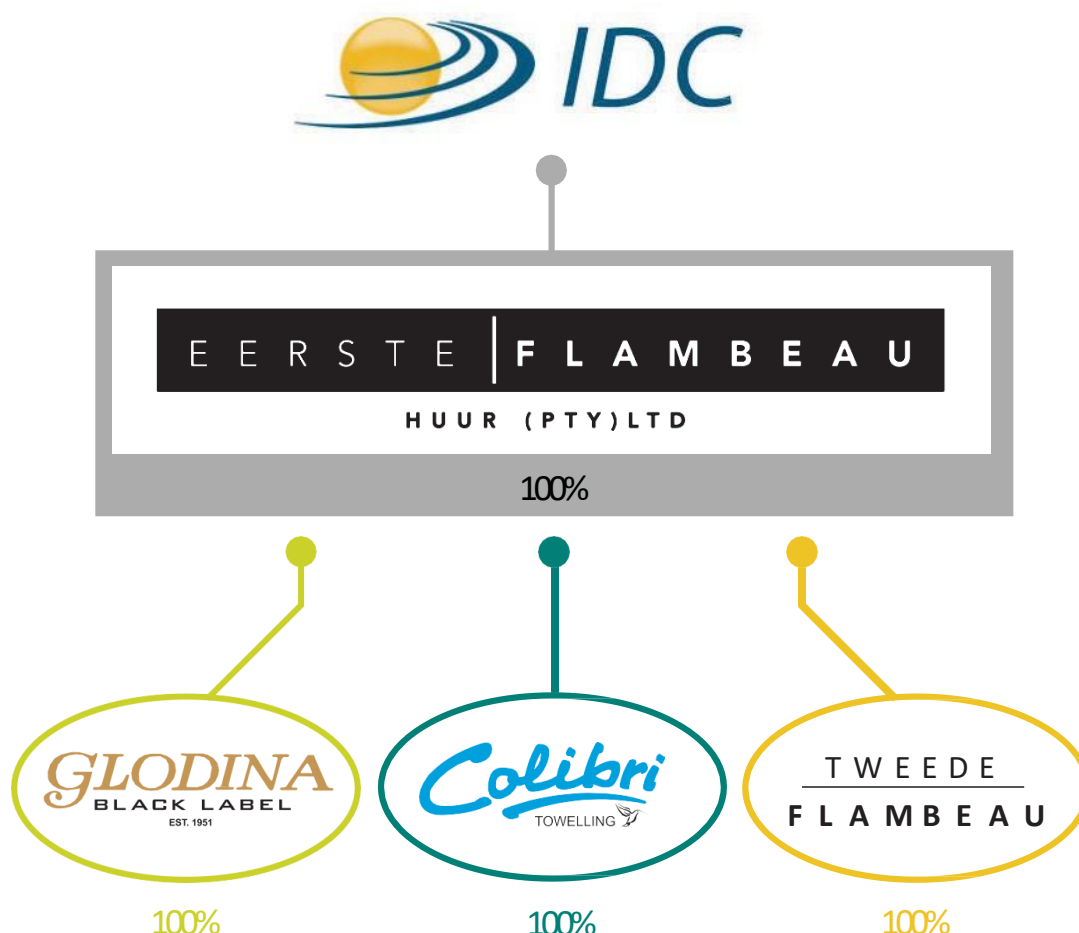

2. SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND

The Eerste Flambeau Huur (Pty) Ltd (“Eerste Flambeau”) is a 100% subsidiary of the Industrial Development Corporation of South Africa (IDC). Eerste Flambeau is an investment entity incorporated in South Africa with interest in the textile industry. The company does not trade, and all of its activities are undertaken through its principal subsidiaries. Eerste owns 100% interest in Colibri Towelling Western Cape (Pty) Ltd (“Colibri”), Glodina Towelling (Pty) Ltd (“Glodina”) - the manufacturing entity, and Tweede Flambeau (Pty) Ltd (“Tweede Flambeau”), the property holding company. The group was formed following a restructure in October 2019.

2.1 GROUP STRUCTURE

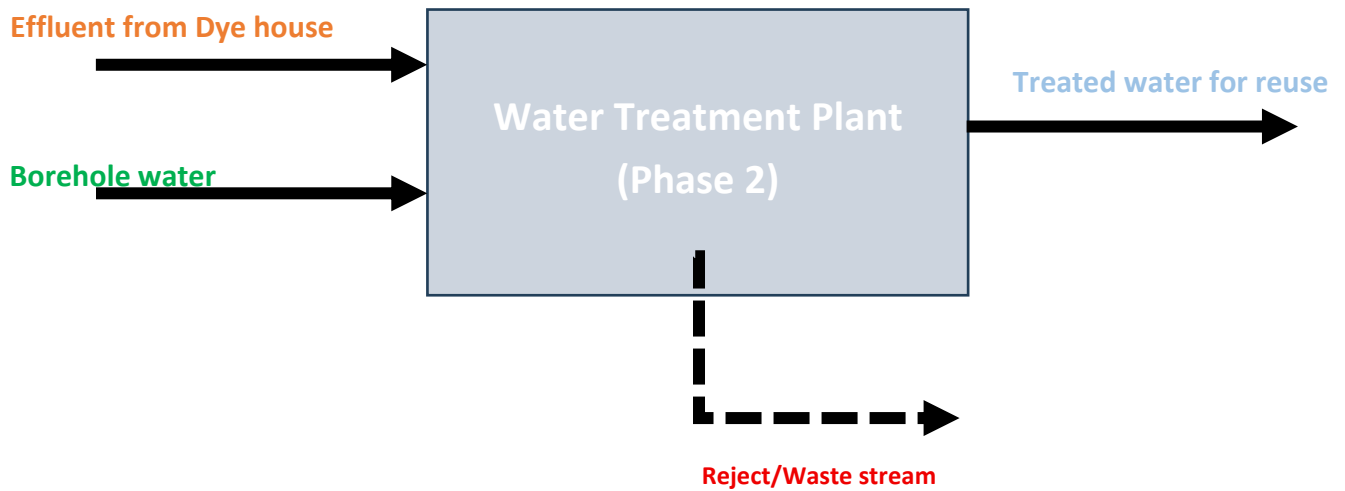


3. SCOPE OF WORK

3.1 PROJECT OVERVIEW

Glodina is a woven and knitted terry-towelling manufacturer based in Hammarsdale, Kwa-Zulu Natal. The facility currently treats industrial effluent generated from its operations to a point where it complies to the local municipal discharge limits, this work was undertaken as part of Wastewater Treatment Plant – Phase One (details of this system are presented in section 3.3).

An additional treatment facility is required to treat a blend of effluent from the dye facility, deemed Phase 2. This scope of work entails the detailed design of a water treatment plant which will be used to improve water recovery and achieve a consistent effluent quality. The effluent is made up of high-colour streams, predominantly originating from insoluble VAT dyes and the low-colour streams are required to be treated such that they can be reused in the production process. Boreholes can be used in the process.



3.2 DESIGN BASIS

This section covers the main parameters to be used for the design of the WWTP plant.

3.2.1 Hydraulic Design

The proposed WTP facility is to be designed to conform with the following:

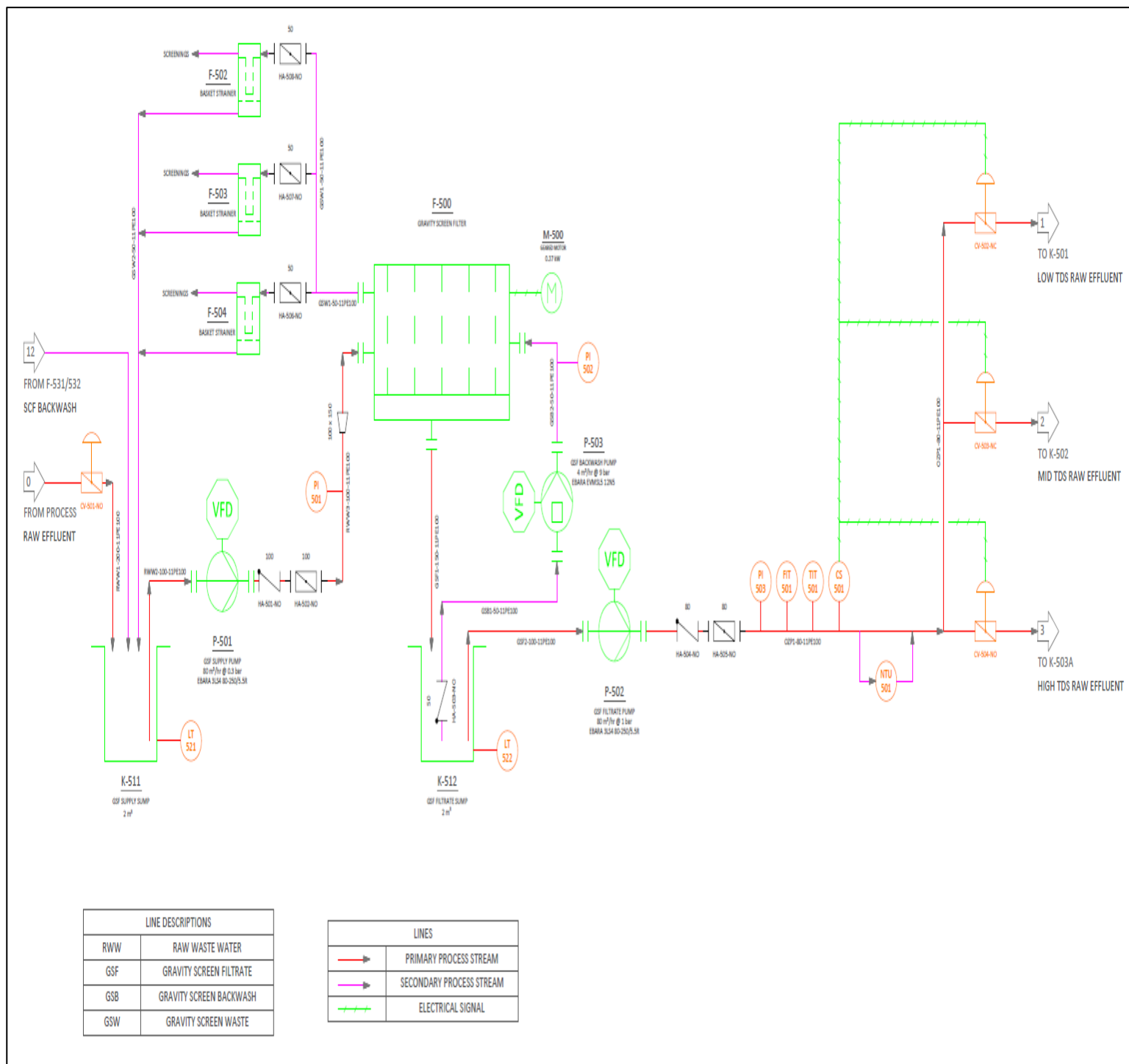

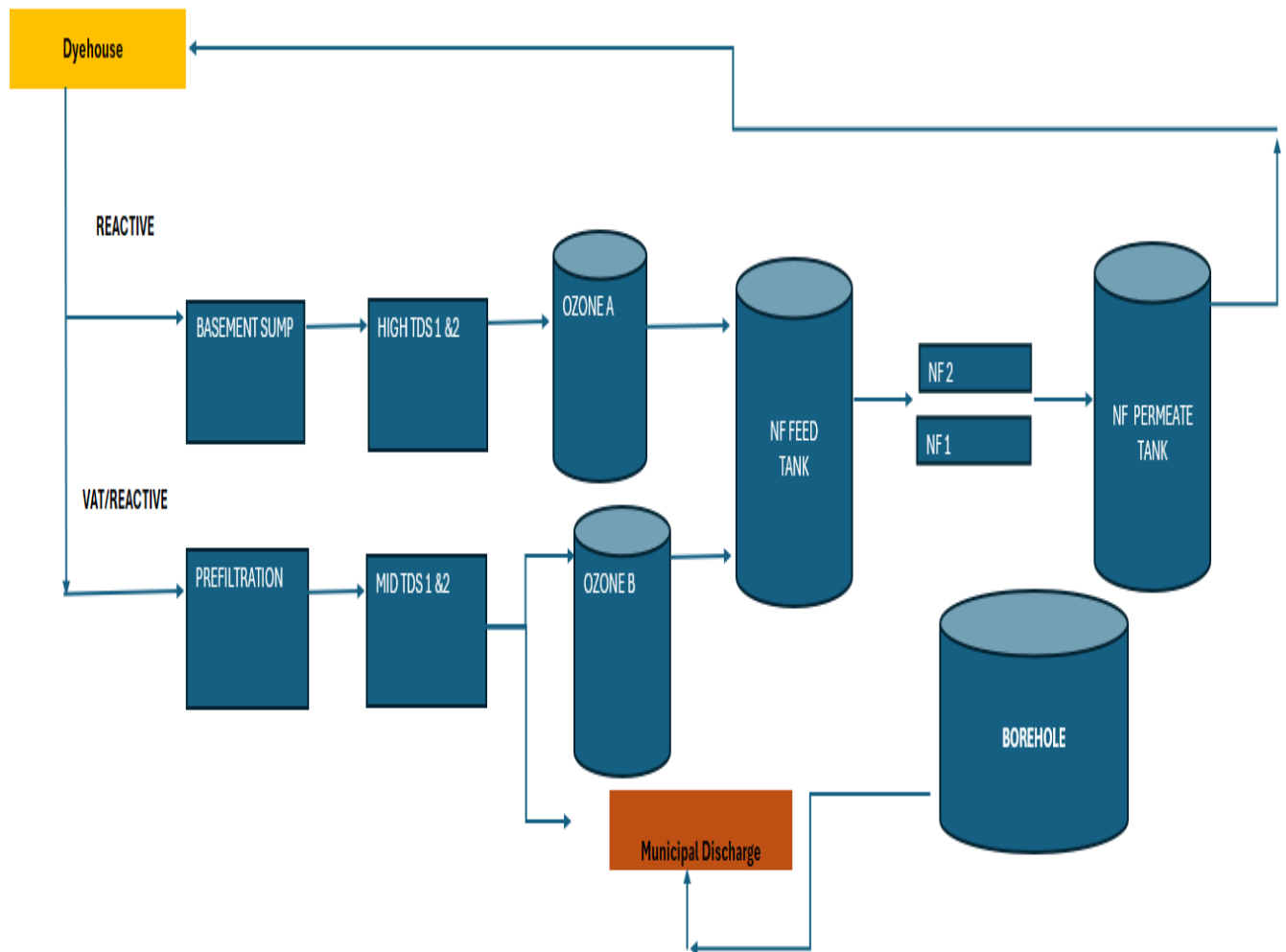
3.3 EXISTING WATER TREATMENT PLANT DESCRIPTION

Small Works 'quality limits apply for catchments leading to sewage works with less than 25 Mℓ/d capacity.
