Q –Reference to Page 8 Item 2, It makes specific reference to a Civil Engineer. Would a BSc in Construction Management be regarded as compliant?

A – No, only Civil Engineering qualification as specified in the functionality criteria would be compliant. 0 points would be obtained for this criterion if the requirements are not met.

Q - The trickle supply and shut off supply, points 3 and 4 of the pricing schedule mention that the Municipality will supply the stopcock to effect the trickle and shut-off. The restrict water supply, point 2, is silent in this regard. My question is if the Municipality will supply the flow limiting device, or must the contractor supply the device? The reason for the question is that there are so many different devices in use at Municipalities and there is a vast difference in the pricing and quality of these devices. If the contractor must supply the device, it would be appreciated if a basic specification can be supplied so that quality standards are maintained.

A - The City will provide a restrictor disk.

Q - We would also like to know how many contractors are intended to be appointed for this tender,

A - One contractor.
