



Remuneration And Benefits Non-Compulsory Briefing – 17 June 2025

On 17 June 2025, merSETA held a non-compulsory briefing session to address the questions, enquiries and clarifications regarding the advertised tender of the above-mentioned.

The following are the questions raised during the briefing session with answers:

1. What is the merSETA current head count as it stands?

Response:

The current head count is two hundred and eighty-nine (289) employees and this number is subject to change.

2. Does merSETA regard not being accredited with Paterson job evaluation a deal breaker or is it just based on the fact that you would get scored zero for this?

Response:

As per the terms of reference, it states as follows: *“Any bid that fails to meet the overall minimum threshold or has not received a score for any individual component thresholds will be disqualified.”*

3. What is the number of roles or positions at the merSETA.

Response:

The merSETA has one hundred and thirty (130) positions (not employees) and this number is subject to change.
