1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this memorandum is to:

- a. Request the Director-General's to approve a deviation from the normal procurement process in terms of Regulation 16A.6.4 of the Treasury Regulations to renew the EASYDATA services for a period of three (3) years.

2. BACKGROUND AND MOTIVATION

2.1 The EasyData subscription is used extensively for the Standardised South African Industry Database; South African Industry Forecast Database; South African Social Accounting Matrix Database and the RSA International Trade database, forming a crucial part of the outcome of Economic Policy's policy analysis work.

2.2 EPIC uses these reports widely to get up to date information on the trade data as well as the performance of specific sectors.

2.2.1 The EasyData Service comprises of four separate services:

- a. Macroeconomic Service – A combination of indicator time-series covering all aspects of the South African economy and a selection of key global indicators.

- b. Industry Service – A disaggregated and consistent long-term view of South Africa's economic structure by industry at the 3-digit ISIC level.
- c. International trade Services – A detailed historic dataset of South Africa's merchandise trade together with an overview of bilateral global trade, as reported by the South African Revenue Service (SARS).
- d. Regional Service – A disaggregated and consistent view of South Africa's socio-economic structure and market potential on a regional basis down to district and town council level.

2.3 Quantec is the sole provider of Easydata. (See attached Annexure A)

2.4 Due to the sole provider status, inviting competitive bids for the procurement of the software and related licenses is not feasible, thereby justifying the renewal

3 LEGAL PRESCRIPTS

3.1 This is a request for approval to deviate from a normal procurement process, pursuant to regulation 16A6.4 of the Treasury Regulations read with paragraph 4.1 of Instruction No. 3 of 2021/22 and paragraph 4.5.7.2 of the Supply Chain Management Policy.

3.2 Regulation 16A6.4 gives authority to the accounting officer to dispense with a procurement process to the extent that they are rendered impractical by prevailing circumstances and to record reasons for deviation. It states that *if in a specific case it is impractical to invite competitive bids, the accounting officer or accounting authority may procure the required goods or services by other means, provided that the reasons for deviating from inviting competitive bids must be recorded and approved by the accounting officer or accounting authority.*

3.3 Supply Chain Management Policy, paragraph 4.5.7.2 indicates Sole source/Supplier where there is evidence that once supplier holds rights to the distribution of the service.

We have conducted desktop analysis to verify sole provider (Quantec) and we can confirm that they are the only provider for EasyData in South Africa see the information below:

I couldn't find any evidence of *resellers* of EasyData in South Africa beyond the owner (Quantec) itself. From the information available:

1. **Quantec** is the provider of EasyData. [Quantec+2Quantec+2](#)
2. EasyData is described as a subscription service by Quantec, with no mention of third-party resellers. [EasyData Help+2Quantec+2](#)
3. Examples of use include universities (e.g. NWU via library access), but that's access rather than resale. [North-West University Library Guides](#)

Dear Joanne,

We are asked to advise on the memorandum ("memo") from the Economic Policy and International Cooperation Division ("EPIC"), requesting approval for a deviation in terms of Regulation 16A6.4 of the Treasury Regulations to renew the EasyData subscription services, provided by Quantec, for a period of three (3) years commencing 01 January 2026 to 31 December 2028.

Our understanding of the memo is that the EasyData subscription underpins several databases critical to EPIC's modelling and policy analysis work. The subscription is used widely across EPIC to obtain up-to-date sectoral and trade information, and it is positioned as integral to the division's outputs.

The memo further informs us that Quantec is the sole provider of the EasyData service. This is the basis on which EPIC motivates that inviting competitive bids would not be feasible, thereby justifying the proposed deviation.

While we agree that Regulation 16A6.4 of the Treasury Regulations, paragraph 4.1 of PFMA SCM Instruction No. 3 of 2021/22 and paragraph 4.5.7.2 of National Treasury's Supply Chain Management ("NT SCM") Policy allow for a deviation where, amongst others, it is impractical to invite competitive bids, we wish to bring to your attention that paragraph 2.3 of the memo states that Quantec is the sole provider of EasyData. Annexure A to the memo provides a supporting letter from Quantec confirming that it is the sole proprietor of both the EasyData Service and the web-based interface through which the service is delivered. The letter further states that EasyData is unique, proprietary, and available exclusively from Quantec, and that Quantec is the sole reseller and distributor of the service. This aligns with paragraph 4.5.7.2 of the NT SCM Policy, which requires evidence that only one source/supplier possesses the unique capacity to provide the service, supported by a sole source letter. On the face of it, Annexure A appears to meet this requirement. However, per paragraph 4.5.7.2(g), the SCM Unit must verify the supplier's sole provider status prior to submission for approval. We could not find any indication that such verification has taken place.

3.
