iLembe District Municipality invites Established Contractors to bid for Driefontein Housing Bulk Sanitation Scheme Phase 1: The Construction Of A New Pumpstation D And Associated Rising And Gravity Mains Bulk Pipelines.

Only bidders who are registered with CIDB or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than 7CE are eligible to bid.

Bid Specification Documents together with the bid drawings will be available from **Thursday, 16 April 2026** until the close of business on **Thursday, 23 April 2026** at **15:00** from the offices of the Cashier at iLembe District Municipality, iLembe House, 59/61 Mahatma Gandhi Street, KwaDukuza, upon payment of a **non-refundable cash** payment of **R1000.00**. Bid documents will **NOT** be available for collection at the site inspection meeting.

A **COMPULSORY SITE INSPECTION** will be held at **12H00** on **Friday, 24 April 2026**. Prospective bidders shall meet the Engineer at 12 Haysom Road (Opposite Caltex Garage), KwaDukuza where a site briefing meeting will be held and then proceed to site for inspection. The Engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on other occasion. Prospective bidders are required to bring their copies of the bid specification documents to the site inspection for signing by the Employer or the Engineer. All bids will be signed on site.

Failure to obtain a Bid Specification Document and non-attendance of the site inspection will result in the immediate disqualification of your bid. Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the Municipality.

All bidders must submit a Tax Clearance Certificate, or South African Revenue Services (SARS) UNIQUE PIN to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status online via E-filing. Any bid that does not comply with the bid conditions will be disqualified and will not be considered. iLembe District Municipality Reserves its Right to Verify the Validity of the submitted Tax Clearance Certificates in terms of Section 256 (5) of the Tax Administration Act no.28 of 2011 and will apply MFMA circular 43 and Section 38 of the iLembe District Municipality's SCM Policy where necessary. All bidders that are required by law to prepare Annual Financial Statements (AFS) for auditing purposes must submit audited AFS for the most recent 3 years or since the date of establishment if established during the past three years with their bids. All bidders must be registered on the National Treasury Central Suppliers Database (CSD) and must submit proof of registration with their bids.

Sealed bid endorsed “**Contract No. TS/262/2026: Driefontein Housing Bulk Sanitation Scheme Phase 1: The Construction Of A New Pumpstation D And Associated Rising And Gravity Mains Bulk Pipelines**”, must be submitted into the Bid Box situated on the **Ground Floor of iLembe Technical Services Offices at 12 Haysom Road, KwaDukuza** by no later than **12 Mid-Day on Monday, 18 May 2026** where they will be opened in public. The name and address of the bidder must be clearly written on the envelope containing the bid. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of iLembe District Municipality’s Supply Chain Management Policy in two stages. The first stage of evaluation is functionality and the second stage being the 80/20 preference point scoring system. Only bidders who score the minimum threshold for functionality will qualify for the second stage of evaluation. The bid will further be evaluated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 pertaining to the PPPFA (No. 5 of 2000)

The Functionality Evaluation Criteria will be conducted in terms of the following: -

Key personnel (Contract manager, Site Agent, Senior Foreman, Health and Safety Officer)	40 Points
Methodology	10
Quality Control	10
Maximum Points = 100	Minimum Threshold = 70 Points (100*70)
