ADDENDUM TO TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER/CONSULTANT TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL SUPPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT AND MONITOR INTEGRATED PUBLIC TRANSPORT NETWORKS (IPTNS) IN THE CLUSTER A MUNICIPALITIES OF CAPE TOWN, GEORGE AND NELSON MANDELA BAY

SUMMARY

This Addendum is issued in respect of Tender No. DOT/10/2026/PT for the appointment of a service provider/consultant to provide technical support to the Department and monitor Integrated Public Transport Networks (IPTNs) in the Cluster A municipalities of Cape Town, George and Nelson Mandela Bay.

Following the issuance of Briefing Notes No. 1 on 18 September 2026, the Department has considered the timing of the publication of the clarifications and has resolved to extend the bid closing date in order to afford prospective bidders additional time to consider the clarifications and finalise their bid submissions.

The extension is intended to promote fairness, competitiveness and transparency within the procurement process and to ensure that all prospective bidders are afforded a reasonable opportunity to consider the clarifications contained in the briefing notes when preparing their bids.

1. NATURE OF ADDENDUM

This document constitutes an Addendum to the original tender documentation and must be read together with the Request for Proposal (RFP), Terms of Reference (TOR) and Briefing Notes No. 1 issued by the Department.

The Addendum specifically addresses:

- 1.1** the extension of the bid closing date;
- 1.2** the revised date and time for submission of bids; and
- 1.3** confirmation that all other conditions of the tender remain unchanged.

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Addendum to terms of reference for the appointment of a service provider/consultant to provide technical support to the department and monitor Integrated Public Transport Networks (IPTN's) in the cluster A municipality of Cape Town, George And Nelson Mandela Bay.

2. EXTENSION OF BID CLOSING DATE

2.1 CURRENT POSITION

The tender documentation currently provides for a bid closing date of:

22 September 2026 at 11h00

Following the publication of Briefing Notes No. 1 on 18 September 2026, the Department has determined that an extension of the closing date would be appropriate in order to provide prospective bidders with additional time to consider the clarifications issued and to prepare responsive bids.

2.2 AMENDMENT

The Department hereby informs all prospective bidders that the bid closing date has been extended as follows:

The extension is intended solely to provide prospective bidders with additional time to consider the clarifications contained in Briefing Notes No. 1 and to ensure that bids are prepared with due regard to those clarifications.

Prospective bidders are therefore required to take note of the revised closing date and ensure that their bids are submitted on or before **28 September 2026 at 11h00**.

Any bid received after the amended closing date and time will not be considered.

3. EFFECT OF ADDENDUM

Prospective bidders are advised that:

3.1 This Addendum forms an integral part of the tender documentation.

3.2 The extension of the closing date does not amend the scope of work, evaluation criteria, conditions of bidding, deliverables or any other requirement contained in the original tender documentation.

3.3 The purpose of the extension is to provide prospective bidders with sufficient opportunity to consider the clarifications contained in Briefing Notes No. 1 and prepare their bids accordingly.

4. REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

This Addendum must be read together with:

- The Request for Proposal (RFP);
- The Terms of Reference (TOR); and
- Briefing Notes No. 1 issued on 18 September 2026.

Except for the amendment to the bid closing date contained in this Addendum, all other terms, conditions, specifications, evaluation criteria and requirements contained in the original tender documentation remain unchanged.

Where there is any inconsistency between this Addendum and the original tender documentation, the provisions of this Addendum shall take precedence.
