No.	QUESTION	ANSWER
Q1.	Please provide clarity on Clause 5.1.7 from C1.2 of the Contract Data (Book 2).	Clause 5.1.7 of the Contract Data in Book 2 states as follows: <i>“The Service Provider shall enter into a contract over the full contract duration (either through partnership, joint venture or sub-contracting) with a Targeted Enterprise(s) to perform a percentage of work as stated in the Contract Data.”</i> As per Note No.1 in Form B7 – <i>“Minimum sub-contracting requirement for all Entities is 30% - refer to Clause 11.7 of the Conditions of Contract.”</i> The Tenderer shall therefore enter into a sub-contract with the stipulated minimum percentage, for the full contract duration.
Q2.	Please provide clarity on the 25% referred to in the first paragraph of Clause 11.2 from C1.2.2 of the Contract Data (Book 2).	The first paragraph of Clause 11.2 of the Contract Data in Book 2 states as follows: <i>“The Service Provider shall not sub-contract more than 25% of the tendered contract value (including value of work allocated to Targeted Enterprise(s) but excluding any services specified in the Scope of Works to be procured under a Provisional Sum through the Employer’s Supply Chain Procurement process) to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level, unless the intended sub-contractor(s) is an Exempted Micro Enterprise that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.”</i> The limit of 25% applies only to <i>“any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level, unless the intended sub-contractor(s) is an Exempted Micro Enterprise that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.”</i> The minimum 30% sub-contracting requirement as per the Contract and Form B7 still applies.
