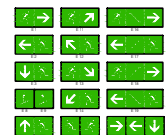
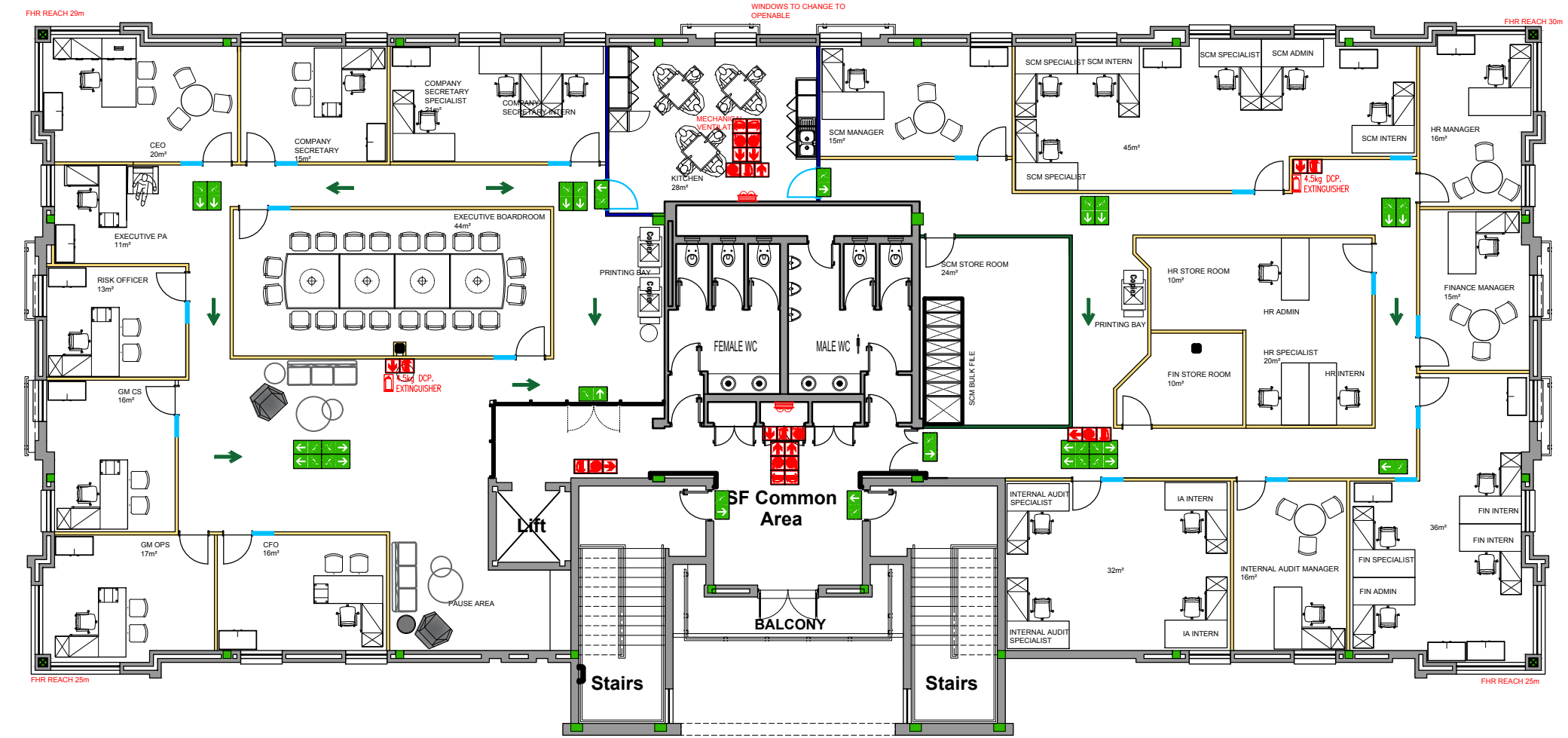




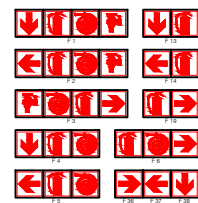

EMERGENCIES

- In the event of fire or other emergency;
- Raise the alarm
 - Notify the Control Room or Fire Brigade and report emergency
 - Extinguish fire if it is safe to do so
 - Evacuate building through nearest exit
- On hearing the fire alarm, evacuate building immediately;
- Do not panic, remain calm
 - Walk in a single file and keep to the left
 - Walk briskly, but do not run
 - Assist injured, elderly and disabled persons in evacuating the building in an orderly fashion
 - Follow the safety signs; indicating the location of fire fighting equipment and emergency escape routes and doors
 - Evacuate through nearest safe emergency exit
 - If possible switch off all electrical appliances
 - In case of fire, close windows and doors as you evacuate
 - Do not use elevators
 - Listen to special instructions given by Fire Marshalls
 - Do not shout or make unnecessary noise
 - Do not interfere with persons performing emergency duties
 - Go straight to the "Assembly Point."
 - Complete attendance register and report persons missing
 - Do not re-enter building until it is authorized by Centre Management
