The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) invites tenders for the provision of consulting engineering services for the emergency repairs to slope embankment and pavement failures on the south bound carriageway of National Route 2 Section 23, between km 49.30 and km 50.30. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal and in the eThekweni Metro Municipality and the approximate programme is for design and construction documentation to be completed by *April 2023* followed by supervision of 6 months, commencing *June 2023*.

Only tenderers with a B-BBEE contributor status level of 1, 2, 3 or 4, who meets the minimum requirements for the key persons, who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database at the tender closing date as stipulated in Clause C.2.1, are eligible to tender.

Joint Ventures (JV) will be allowed on condition that one JV partner is a Targeted Enterprise. The JV partner will, however, not contribute to sub-contract target for Targeted Enterprises.
