4.2 Additional Services

4.2.6 Security Services

- The provision of Security services on an ad-hoc basis, as may be needed to ensure that the City of Cape Town and/or contractors personnel safety requirements are met.
- The Security Contractor shall take every precaution to ensure safety and protection of the personnel from criminal activities such as criminal attacks, robberies etc. in their respective working environments. The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety and security of his personnel, materials on site and the Works in general at all times. The Contractor shall therefore acquaint himself with the current situation in the area with regard to safety and security (liaising with the local police as necessary) and shall provide all security measures, including the employment of accredited security services, as deemed necessary to comply with the requirements under this clause on the Contract.
- All security staff employed by the supplier on behalf of the CCT or at any CCT property must be registered with Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSiRA). Proof of such registration must be made available to the CCT's agent upon request.
