TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ)

1. **Broadband Infraco** standard conditions of purchase shall apply.
2. No services must be rendered or goods delivered before an official **Broadband Infraco Purchase Order** form has been received.
3. Late and incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
4. Any bidder who has reasons to believe that the RFQ specification is based on a specific brand must inform **Broadband Infraco** before RFQ closing date.
5. Work will be carried out in terms of OHSA regulations therefore it is important that bidders include OHSA compliance costs (i.e. safety file for the recommended bidder will be approved by Broadband Infraco).
6. **Effective 01 April 2016, accounting officers and accounting authorities may not award any bid to a supplier/ service provider not registered as a prospective supplier in the National Treasury's central Supplier Database. Please attach the first page of your CSD registration to the bid response.**
7. Bidder is required to submit an original Tax Clearance Certificate and verification information to be used by Broadband Infraco to validate the copy on the SARS website for all price quotations exceeding the value of **R30 000 (VAT included)**. Failure to submit the copy of a valid Tax Clearance Certificate and verification information will result in the invalidation of this RFQ. It is the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that **Broadband Infraco** is in possession of the bidder's valid **Tax Clearance certificate**. It is therefore not necessary to submit a tax clearance certificate if the bidder has submitted a tax clearance for any RFQ/bid before at **Broadband Infraco**. The onus is on the bidder to ensure that Broadband Infraco receives a valid Tax Certificate as soon as the validity of the said certificate expires.
8. Bidders are required to complete **Annexure A** for all price quotations exceeding the value of **R30 000 (VAT included)**.

9. Bidders must attach a valid BBBEE certificate or valid exemption letter with the bid.
10. This RFQ will be evaluated in terms of the **80/20 preference point system** prescribed by the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011.
11. All prices must be quoted in South African Rand (ZAR) and the foreign currency amount applicable must be stated. The bidder must indicate **clearly** which portion of the quoted price is linked to the exchange rate. The cost of installation, delivery, and other charges must be included in the total price quoted.
12. Broadband Infraco will only commence payment processes after fulfilment of the conditions contained in the contract and/or on receipt of an invoice from the service provider and after such has been approved by the client division as representing the services received.
13. Payment of invoices will be effected on the last day of the calendar month following the calendar month of receipt of a correct and original invoice
14. Bidders who submitted information that is fraudulent, factually untrue or inaccurate, for example memberships that do not exist, BEE credentials, experience, etc. will be disqualified.

 - (f) bidding with the intention not to win the bid.
8. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
9. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the Service Provider, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.

10. I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
