1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 To seek approval to appoint SABC and MSG group Sales for the placement of the Jobs Fair Thohoyandou campaign according to Supply Chain Management Delegation requirements (4.3) in line with National Treasury instruction note no. 3 of 2021/22.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Department of Employment and Labour will be hosting a Job/Career fair in Thohoyandou, Limpopo Province. The initiative is in line with the Departments' contribution to employment creation. The two-day event earmarked for the 27th – 28th July 2023, is aimed at raising awareness around career development and the important socio-economic benefits to the country and the quality of life for the work seekers.
- 2.2 The event will be held under the theme "Pathways to quality career development". This event will be the first of its kind to be held concurrently at a large scale in the country wherein work seekers will meet with prospective employers and other organisations or departments that can assist with their placement in different forms of employment or learning opportunities. The Department of Employment and Labour's Employment Counsellors will be providing their expertise in training job seekers on job hunting skills, how to conduct themselves during interviews in order to attract prospective employers and networking. It is against this background that GCIS is implementing this campaign.

- 3.1 To create awareness to work seekers, learners and employers about the employment initiatives of the Department.
- 3.2 To increase the levels of understanding on labour-related matters.

To seek approval to appoint SABC and MSG Group for the placement of the Jobs fair Thohoyandou

- 3.2 To increase the levels of understanding on labour-related matters. To increase the number of people engaged in various economic activities, reduce unemployed and discouraged work seekers and contribute to the socio-economic upliftment of the communities of Thohoyandou.

Radio is ideal for this campaign as it will be able to reach communities around the area of Thohoyandou and communities close by. It allows for the audience to be reached in their own languages. Radio is therefore recommended based on relevance as per the approved Media Buying Standard Operating Procedure (SOP).

6.2 DELEGATION 4.3 ACQUISITION OF RADIO THRESHOLD R3 000 000.00 CAMPAIGN TOTAL R400 531.78

6.2.1 In order to reach the selected target audiences and deliver on the campaign's objectives, Media Buying recommends the use of commercial and community radio stations that are relevant to the campaign objectives and target audience.

6.2.2 The recommended radio stations for this campaign are **SABC's** Phalaphala (1 142 000), Munghana lo Nene (1 440 000) and **MSG Group Sales'** Capricorn FM (483 000). These stations are relevant to the campaign's objectives and target audience. The client intends to invite communities around Thohoyandou to attend the Job Fair, this will consist of work seekers, employers and community-based organisations. The message will be communicated using an Outside Broadcast OB (Phalaphala) and live reads. Memo for community radio is still due. *(Source: BRC RAMS Nov'21 – Oct'22. This research was conducted prior to the lapsing of the Telmar contract hence the unavailability of a regional/ provincial analysis of radio coverage in Limpopo.*
