REQUEST FOR CONTRACT EXTENSION: APPOINTMENT OF AIRPORTS COMPANY OF SOUTH AFRICA (ACSA)

1. National Treasury acknowledges receipt of your letter dated 10 January 2021.
2. SACAA requests the National Treasury to approve extension of a contract awarded to ACSA for provision of office accommodation in Cape Town office in the amount of R7 618 527.21 for a period of five (5) years effective 01 February 2022. The contract has already been extended from 01 November 2021 to 31 January 2022 in the amount of R328 276.53, which is 5% of the original contract. The original contract was for a period of five (5) years from 01 November 2016 until 31 October 2021 in the amount of R6 138 712.80. This amounts to total variation of 123.4%.
3. The submission was signed by Chief Financial Officer on 10 January 2022.
4. The reason provided for contract extension is that SACAA has invested a lot in the office in Cape Town and moving out of the current office is not economical.

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5. The reason provided is justifiable because moving to another office is not economical.
6. National Treasury supports the contract extension.
7. Your Institution has an obligation to ensure that any contract for goods and services is in accordance with the system which is fair, equitable, transparent, competitive and cost-effective.
