Reason why tender outcome was published late:

On 16 February 2022, the Constitutional Court issued a judgement regarding the invalidity of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) Regulations, 2017. SARS was awaiting the outcome of the appeal by National Treasury to decide on whether the tender should be awarded or cancelled.

On 31 May 2022, National Treasury issued a Media Statement - Constitutional Court Judgement regarding PPR 2017. The Constitutional Court confirmed that the suspension of the declaration of the order of invalidity of the 2017 Regulations is still valid for the remainder of the 12-month period, namely until 15 February 2023. This means that the 2017 Regulations in their entirety are still valid.
