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Lions coach Van Rooyen heaps praise on match-winner Sanele Nohamba

Though he gave credit to the entire team in their 29-25 United Rugby Championship (URC) win over the Bulls on Saturday at Loftus, Lions coach Ivan van Rooyen made special mention of Sanele Nohamba.

The scrumhalf was the difference maker on the day with a solid return of 24 points from a try, five penalties and two conversions as the Lions registered their first win in Pretoria since 2017.

The result meant the Lions refreshed their faint hopes of qualifying for the play-offs.

"Players like that, you need them when you have your backs against the wall to show special moments and I thought Sanele was special today [Saturday] in that sense."

"I am really honest about it, you have to play to be consistent and to up your game. I don't think anyone ever doubted his ability given that whether he is coming from the bench or starting, everyone can see the consistency in his performances."

"There are things to work on and he is well aware of that. We are putting a lot of emphasis on play-makers to make decisions."

"His point of difference at the moment is that his decision-making has been good."

Van Rooyen said the win was a huge result for the battling Lions and may prove a turning point in

their season.

"I was speaking to someone and I think our last win here [at Loftus] was in 2017, so it is a big moment for us. I am immensely proud of the work rate and fight."

"Where we have grown the most over the past two weeks is with regards to intensity and intent in training. I am just happy for the guys to display it on the field."

With the Currie Cup fast approaching, Van Rooyen said the Gauteng side will give opportunities to players who did not get enough minutes in the URC.

"Some of the guys will play against Western Province, some of the others will play the weekend after against the Pumas [both in the Currie Cup] and then we fly to Benetton [in the URC]. For these two weeks, the guys who are short on game time in positions where we feel we have don't enough depth should get a crack."

"It is good for everyone to play someone like Ruan Smith who played himself back into the team through Currie Cup games [last season], and it is a lot better to play than just to train without games."

Djokovic withdraws from Indian Wells amid US visa row

Novak Djokovic has formally withdrawn from the draw for the Indian Wells tournament, organisers said on Sunday in an indication that the world number one's application for a Covid-19 vaccine waiver to enter the US might have failed.

The Serbian, who is one of the most high-profile athletes unvaccinated against the virus, applied to the US government last month for special permission to play at ATP Masters events at Indian Wells and Miami.

"World Number 1 Novak Djokovic has withdrawn from the 2023 BNP Paribas Open. With his withdrawal, Nikoloz Basilashvili moves into the field," organisers said on Sunday.

The US bars unvaccinated foreigners from entry into the country, a policy that is expected to be lifted when the government ends its Covid-19 emergency declarations on May 11.

Djokovic has not competed at the back-to-back ATP Masters events in Indian Wells and Miami, two of the biggest tournaments on the ATP calendar and known as the "Sunshine Double", since 2019.

No-one from Djokovic's team was immediately available to comment on the withdrawal.

Last Friday, Florida Senators Rick

Scott and Marco Rubio wrote a letter to US President Joe Biden urging him to grant the waiver request.

Indian Wells tournament director Tommy Haas, the US Tennis Association and the US Open were among those also hoping the 22-time Grand Slam champion would be allowed to enter.

He would have been a heavy favourite to win his sixth Indian Wells title when the tournament

kicks off in the Southern California desert on Wednesday.

Djokovic, who missed last year's Australian Open due to his vaccination status and was not allowed into the US for last year's US Open, has said he would skip Grand Slams rather than have a Covid-19 shot.

He won his record-tying 22nd major championships at the Australian Open in January. — Reuters

McIlroy's relaxed approach an issue in majors — Nicklaus

Jack Nicklaus knows a thing or two about winning a major tournament.

Heck, he's won 18 of them. So when asked why Rory McIlroy hasn't won a major since 2014, the 83-year-old Nicklaus didn't hold back.

"He's got the best rhythm in the game. He uses his body better than anybody else. I love his attitude," Nicklaus said this week on Nick Faldo's new podcast, Sir Nick's Round Table Chats.

"But I don't think Rory — he has (trouble) keeping his focus for some reason. I don't know what it is."

Nicklaus went on to say that McIlroy "just plays golf. And sometimes, you really can't just play golf."

Faldo asked Nicklaus to expound on that.

"Well, I look at Augusta," Nicklaus said. "Everybody knows Augusta pretty much. There are about six shots at Augusta that you better pay attention to your tee shot at 2, your second shot at 11, your tee shot at 12, your tee shot at 13, the second shot at 15, and the (second) shot at 15."

"Those six shots, if you've played those shots smart, play them intelligently and put them in the conservative side of the ledger, the rest of the golf course is not very hard. And so Rory, sometimes, gets caught up in just playing golf and all of a sudden: Where did that eight come from? — Field Level Media
