T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER (SBD1)

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) invites tenders for the Training and Construction Management of a community development project to upgrade access roads and stormwater system in and near Kwaggafontein A. This project is in the Province of Mpumalanga and in the Nkangala District Municipality. The approximate duration of the Contract is 18 months, including 3 months for the Mobilisation Period

It is estimated that Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 8 CE or higher, however Tenderers' attention is drawn to the Tender Data, clause C.2.1 (a) when submitting their tender.

Tenders from Tenderers registered as potentially emerging enterprises but with a CIDB contractor grading designation lower than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered, or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, will not be accepted.

Only tenderers who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database and meet the minimum requirements for Tenderer's relevant experience as stipulated in Clause C.2.1 at the tender closing date, are eligible to tender.

It is a requirement of this project that the successful tenderer subcontract a minimum of 30 percent (30 %) or higher as tendered of the work by the end of the contract to Targeted Enterprise(s) as defined in the Contract Data.

Failure to submit this certificate would result in the tenderer not receiving addenda or additional issued information and may result in the tenderer being non-responsive, if "any material amendment/s" contained in the addenda or additional information is not included in the tender offer/submission.
