Failure to attend the compulsory briefing meeting will result in the tenderer's bid being rejected or disqualified. Locally produced or manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum thresholds for local production and content for all Designated Sectors in the Declaration Certificate (MBD6.2) will be considered.

Tenderer(s) will be required to subcontract a minimum of 30% of the value of contract to the Targeted Enterprise.
