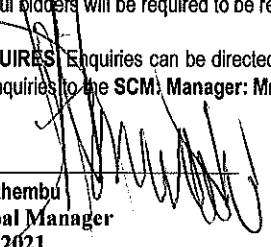

COMPULSORY SITE BRIEFING: Prospective Bidders are required to attend a compulsory Bid briefing and site briefing meeting with the Municipality representatives at the municipal Council Chamber, Lot 808, Off Masson Street, Hlabisa on the date and time listed above. No Documents will be sold after the site briefing meeting.

CLOSING DATE: Completed and sealed bid documents bearing the project name and bid number "UPGRADE OF HLABISA TAXI RANK PHASE 2, Bid No. B5H2020/21-14 must be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices, lot 808, Off Masson Street, Hlabisa, 3937 on or before 10h00 on 15th July 2021. Telegraphic, telephonic, telefax, facsimile, e-mailed and late bids will not be accepted. Envelopes containing the bid document should be clearly marked with the returnable address at the back of the envelope. All bids submitted shall remain valid for 90 days after the closing date.

EVALUATION: The evaluation of the bid will be conducted in two stages: first stage, the assessment of the functionality will be done in terms of the evaluation criteria and the minimum threshold. Second stage, the bids that meet the minimum threshold of 60% will then be evaluated in terms of 80/20 preference point system, where 80 points will be for price and 20 points for the BBEE status level of contribution. Big 5 Hlabisa Municipality subscribes to Municipal Supply Chain. Failure to complete all Bid forms, data sheets and submit all supplementary information may render the bid to be considered as non-responsive and therefore not to be considered for the award of the contract. Successful bidders will be required to be registered with the Municipal database prior commencement of project.
