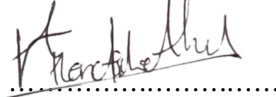
A sample Hazardous Waste Data Sheet made reference in the response is attached to this notice.

No.	Question	Response
1	Please supply a list of the current sites where these services are supplied?	Since this is a City Wide tender, sites to collect from could be anywhere within the City of Cape Town Metropolitan Boundaries. Also note that it is an as and when required tender, so any site could be added at any time
2	Solid and Liquid Hazardous waste: Can we please receive a copy of the current Waste data sheet for the hydrocarbon contaminated solid waste?	Attached is a sample of a typical waste data sheet for the hazardous waste. The tender provides for carbon containing hazardous waste.
3	If a copy can't be received, please advise where can we collect sample of waste?	Please refer to question 2 above and attached data sheet
4	Item 6.25 and 6.26 on the pricing sheet refer to hazardous chemical liquids? Are there current data sheets or samples available?	There are no data sheets for the liquid hydrocarbons. All of it is currently recycled and the recycler accepted the liquids based on the MSD Sheets supplied with each batch. All liquid hazardous waste currently produced is recyclable. Should any liquid hazardous waste not be recyclable, it will be dealt with on a case by case basis during the contract operations.
5	Item 3 of the pricing sheets note 210Liter Otto bins. Standard Otto bins are 240L, can this item be tendered?	The standard Otto bin size is indeed 240 litres
6	Providing the address or names of the collection points that the waste is coming from.	Since this is a City Wide tender, sites to collect from could be anywhere within the City of Cape Town Metropolitan Boundaries. Also note that it is an as and when required tender, so any site could be added at any time
7	This will help us determine the distance from the site/ collection point to the landfill site and allow us to price accordingly	The specific distances from sites are not required. The tender calls for a per kilometre rate, which will in turn be applied to the applicable distance to the final management site. The per kilometre rate should be standard for any distance travelled from anywhere in the City Municipal Area to the specific final management facility.
8	If I do have a permit to dump the hazardous waste, but not in Cape Town. Is that allowed?	The tenderer would need to submit the relevant permits and certificates in contract stage. (Refer to Section C, paragraph C3: <i>The tenderer must be in possession of the relevant permits, authorisations and certificates for the final management of hazardous waste and provide to the City of Cape Town for scrutiny (Regulations in terms of NEMA Waste Act (2008) Section 24 and 25 as well as National Road Traffic Act pertaining to the registration as waste remover, waste transporter and disposer of waste, waste remover drivers training as well as any other applicable statutory permits not included in this specification).</i> Tenderer must submit the proof of application for City of Cape Town

		permits before contract commencement (refer Specifications Section A). To show that the tenderer is disposing of the hazardous waste legally. If the tenderer chooses to dispose of hazardous waste outside of the boundaries of the City of Cape Town is at an additional cost to the Tenderer/Contractor however all certificates must be valid and from a official disposal site. Please refer to the replacement page 37 Section 6 clauses 6.1 and 6.2
