Hazardous Waste:

“**hazardous waste**” means any waste that contains organic or inorganic elements or compounds that may, owing to the inherent physical, chemical or toxicological characteristics of that waste, have a detrimental impact on health and the environment and includes hazardous substances, materials or objects within business waste, residue deposits and residue stockpiles as outlined in the National Environmental Management Waste Amendment Act, 2014

Storage:

Waste will only be stored temporarily on site within the legal framework (National Norms and Standards for the Storage of Waste, 2013) and with due consideration of the associated risk.

1	210 ℓ DRUMS WITH LIDS FOR HYDROCARBON CONTAMINATED HAZARDOUS WASTE AND/OR BULBS AS WELL AS BATTERIES 210 litre lidded, leak proof drums will be used by the operational sections for the local, on site storage and collection of solid hydrocarbon contaminated hazardous waste, batteries and/or bulbs. The drums will be removed from the site of the operational section. These drums will meet the following minimum requirements:	
1.1	Min size / capacity of 210 ℓ	
1.2	The 210 ℓ drums shall be labelled as hazardous waste	
1.3	The drums shall be labelled indicating the type of hazardous waste permitted in it	
1.4	The drums shall be lidded and leak proof	
1.5	The drums shall be provided and maintained in good condition, free of defects.	
1.6	Drums can be either new or refurbished but must be leak proof with lids	
2	240 ℓ OTTO BINS FOR COLLECTION OF HAZARDOUS WASTE 240 litre Otto bins with hinged lids will be used by the operational sections for the local, on site storage and collection of hazardous waste before being emptied to fill the 6m³ skips for bulk storage on site. The Otto bins will not be removed from the site of the operational section. These Otto bins will meet the following minimum requirements:	
2.1	Min size / capacity of 240 ℓ	
2.2	240 ℓ Otto bins must preferably be Red	
2.3	The Otto bins shall be labelled as hazardous waste	
2.4	The Otto bins shall be labelled indicating the type of hazardous waste permitted in it.	
2.5	The Otto bins shall have a hinged lid	
2.6	The Otto bins shall have wheels	
2.7	The Otto bins shall be provided and maintained in good condition, free of defects.	
2.8	The Otto bins shall carry a monthly rental cost	
2.9	A replacement cost will be payable by a user in case of loss or destruction of a Otto bin by the user on a site
